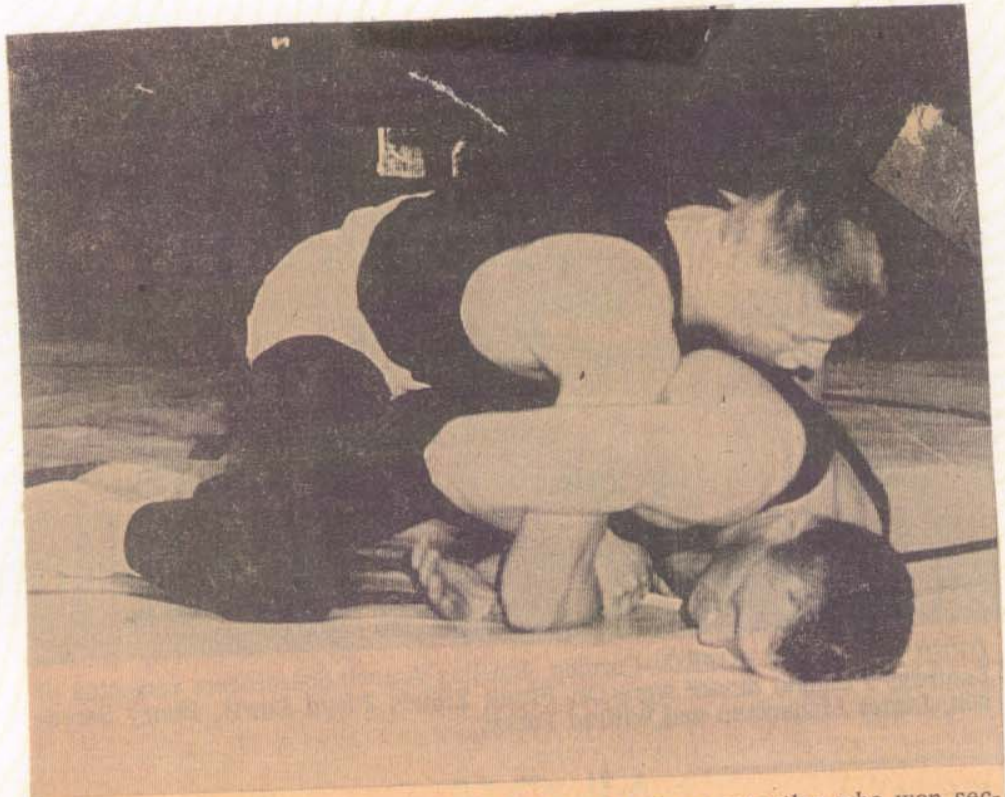

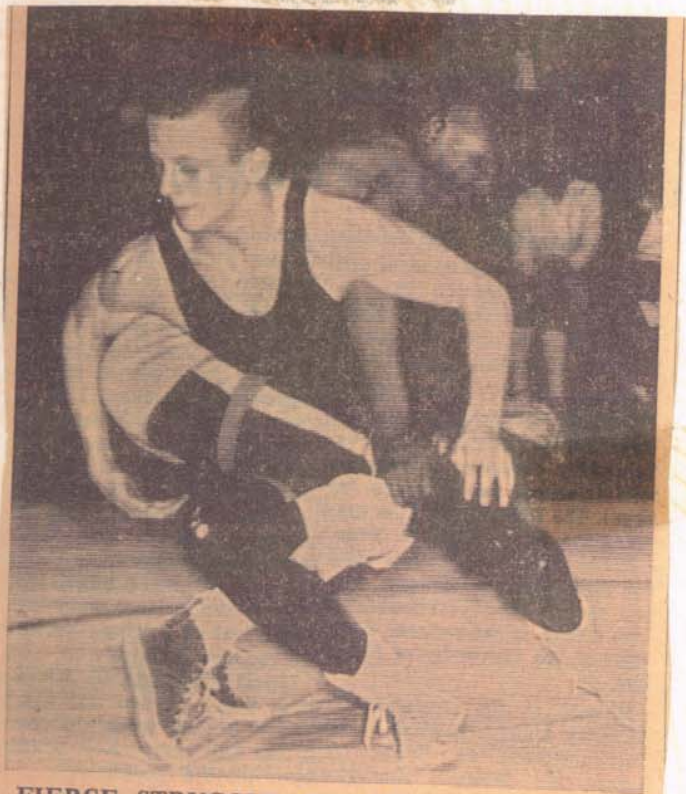

Academy Star Downs Geneva's Dick Post

Although Corning placed five wrestlers in the finals of the Section Five Class "A" Tournament Saturday night at the Glass Center the only local victor was Neal Pipe of Corning Free Academy in the 180 pound division.

Pipe in the final round decisioned Dick Post of Geneva, 6-2. It was a sweet win for the CFA grappler as in the final regular season match of the campaign, Post had beaten Pipe thus stopping his previous winning streak 18 matches.

Corning grapplers bowing out in the finals were Ed Saxbury, Bud Thurber, Bob Turner of CFA and Doug Hoover of Northside.

Madison High of Rochester dominated the action before some 800 spectators with five winners while Franklin High of Rochester had two victors. Schools gaining one championship were Spencerport, East High of Rochester, West High of Rochester, Eastridge and Corning Free Academy.

Certificates to winners and runners-up were Harry Auble of Northside High School and Joseph Corcoran of Corning Free Academy.
