

## Wrestlers Lose Lid-Lifter at Buffalo

The Ashland University wrestling team lost in its season-opening match Saturday (Nov. 7), falling at the University of Buffalo, 31-9.

The Eagles were fine in the lighter weights, winning two of the first three matches. At 125 pounds, **Brandon Davis** stopped Dylan Dabolt, 3-2 in overtime. At 141 pounds, **Scott Meyer** was a 4-2 winner over Andrew Schutt.

That's when trouble struck for the Eagles. Buffalo won at the next six weight classes. That run included two pins and a major decision. The Eagles finally got a win at 285 pounds where **Jacob Southwick** posted a 5-1 triumph over Robert Ruyhal.

This is one of the youngest teams the Eagles have put on the mat in years. On Saturday, second-year head coach **Tim Derlan** started six freshmen and two sophomores.

Ashland's next action comes on Saturday, Nov. 14, when the Eagles host the Harris Open.
