

Canandaigua has 3 Class AA winners —

Rick Moracco: JV to section champ in month

CANANDAIGUA—A month ago, Rick Moracco was wrestling two and three classes above his normal weight on the junior varsity level.

Today, he's a Section 5 champion awaiting a chance to compete in the Intersectional qualifier for the right to go on to the State tournament in Syracuse on March 7 and 8.

Moracco moved up to the Geneva varsity wrestling team when Scott Laise was injured in an accident involving a grinder. By the time Laise got back, he couldn't handle Moracco, who then was entered in the Section 5 Class AA tournament that started last Wednesday in Penn Yan and finished Saturday night in Canandaigua Academy's gym.

Moracco competed in four dual meets, won all four and then added four more victories in the tournament to win the 112 pound championship for Section 5 in Class AA, beating out Canandaigua's Doug Lynn in the finals by a 10-7 score.

The Geneva sophomore joins 38 other wrestlers from Wayne-Finger Lakes, the Southern Tier, Monroe County and Rochester, who finished one-two-three in the 13 weight classes contested in the tourney.

Canandaigua, which won the team championship with 78 points, advanced seven wrestlers to the Intersectional qualifier, including three champions.

Brockport moves five wrestlers to the next step while Wayne Central sends four and Greece Athena send three.

Hornell, Geneva, Newark, Palmyra-Macedon, Dansville, Waterloo, Churchville-Chili and Webster Schroeder each will send two wrestlers while Corning East, Penn Yan, Batavia and Pittsford-Mendon send one each.

While Canandaigua had three individual champions, no other school had more than one. Along with Geneva, Hornell, Newark, Dansville, Waterloo, Churchville-Chili, Webster Schroeder, Greece Athena, Brockport and Wayne each have one winner.

Waterloo's Chris Shaffer, wrestling at heavyweight, and Canandaigua's Bob Hadsell, a 1973 overall Section 5 champion at 98 pounds, were the most impressive competitors in the tournament.

Shaffer pinned all four of his opponents enroute to the heavyweight title, two of them in less than a minute. He nailed Brockport's Scott Kenyon in 3:23 of the championship bout after trailing 3-1 before scoring a takedown and pinning his opponent.

Hadsell, wrestling at 119 pounds, had two pins and then won both of his final two bouts handily, taking the title by scoring a 9-4 decision over Ted Hargarther of Wayne.

The Wayne-Finger Lakes league, which had eight teams in the 20 team event, came through with seven individual champions and will send a majority of one to the Rochester War Memorial, Saturday listing 20 of the 39 eligible wrestlers.

Jeff Gelinas, Canandaigua 98 pounder, started the W-FL off on the right foot when he scored a tough 5-4 decision over Brockport's Gary Freeman in the finals. Gelinas had a 4-1 lead after one period and then held on, thanks to a second period escape.

Canandaigua's Jim White joined Gelinas and Hadsell in the winners' circle when he captured the 126 pound title with a 6-2 decision over Pal-Mac's Scott Helfter. White had a 6-0 lead after two periods and was able to coast in the final period.

Newark's Brian Willemssen became the fifth W-FL wrestler to win a title when he decided Canandaigua's Tom Burgess, 10-3 in the final. Willemssen had scored two pins enroute to the final.

The sixth area wrestler to win a championship was Wayne's Roy Lang, who took the 155 pound crown with a 7-5 win over Dick Gumina of Webster Schroeder. Lang took a 5-0 lead in the first period and then used a pair of second period escapes after Gumina scored a take down and near-fall in the second period.

Three other W-FL wrestlers were beaten in the finals. Geneva's John Zello, after scoring two pins and a decision along the way, was an 11-5 victim of Dansville's Doug Atwell in the 105 pound final. Zello, taking a 5-4 lead after an escape to start the second period, was taken down and put into a three point near-fall in the second period and wasn't able to recover.

Palmyra-Macedon's Gary Jackson reached the finals but then lost a 4-3 decision to Greece Athena's Tom Ciavarri, who won by the margin of a third period penalty point against Jackson.

Wayne's Don VanDuesen was outpointed 16-4 by Brockport's strong Mike Hammerl in the 177 pound final.

Other Class AA champions are Mike Crissy of Hornell, an 8-2 winner over Rick Miller of Brockport at 132 pounds; Tim Taft of Webster Schroeder, a 9-8 winner over Gene DeGudico of Greece Athena at 145 pounds, and Denny Denner of Churchville-Chili, scored a 9-3 win over Gary Whiteman of Dansville in the unlimited (250) division.

Winners and losers in the championship finals, will be joined in Saturday's all-day action at the Rochester War Memorial, by the third place winners, all reaching that spot by wrestling back after losing somewhere along the line to the finals.

Penn Yan's Ron Thompson at 98 pounds, Canandaigua's Mill Torres at 105, Wayne's Frank Affroni at 126, Newark's Harry Allerton at 145, and Waterloo's Dan Fogley at 177, were Wayne-Finger Lakes third place finishers.

Others taking third were Don Gugel of Batavia at 112, Shane Legacy of Churchville-Chili at 119, Chip Toth of Pittsford Mendon at 132, Ken Zadorecky of Greece-Athens at 138, Rick Landries of Brockport at 155, Mike Bacon of Hornell at 167, Jeff Ayres of Corning East at 215, and Dave Zimmerman of Canandaigua at 250.

The Intersections in Rochester, Saturday, begin with weigh-in between 9 and 10:30 a.m. and the first bouts (on four mats) start at 11 a.m. Consolation finals are listed for 6:30 p.m. with the finals set for 8 p.m.

MAT MINUTIA—Moracco, Taft and Atwell were the only three wrestlers to beat the odds. They were the only wrestlers not seeded first. Moracco came from furthest back, he was seeded fifth in the South Division. Taft and Atwell were second seeds in their division. The tournament proved far too big for one day. It took over 13 hours to complete 148 bouts, action not ending until after midnight.

Things got started at 11 a.m. Consolation finals were cut to five minutes instead of the normal six. The first period was one minute long, instead of the regular two minutes.

Jim Winthrop of Mynderse, Ron Fisher of Wayne, Steve Cook of Geneva, Rick Lufey of Wayne, Dean Simmons of Canandaigua and Mark Austin of Newark were W-FL wrestlers just missing out, finishing fourth.
