



Olean Sweeps Into Sectionals With 11 Wrestlers (10 Titlists)

Has There Ever Been A Better-Balanced Mat Crew?

Certainly, there would an argument from several areas, but the question of the wrestling moment goes:

Has there ever been a better balanced crew of wrestlers in Western New York — that's Section 6, five counties — than the current Olean High School squad that practically an-

ihilated the opposition in its division of the Section 6 championships Saturday?

Coach Mike Foster's troops — unbeaten in four seasons of dual competition (47 victories) — collected a whopping 211 points in spread-eagling an eight-team Division IV championship at Williamsville North. In the pro-

cess, Foster's crew emerged with 10 champions and with a finalist, it makes 11 that Olean will have in next Friday-Saturday's Super Section 6 championships at Sweet Home High School.

THERE WERE eight divisional championships with the

top two in each weight class advancing to the Sweet Home action. The winners next weekend — and Foster, a coach who plays it most conservatively, has his sights on "five, maybe six to go on to the state" — advance to Syracuse for the New York State championships.

Chris Leichtweis, the 155

pounder who has "the opposition running away from him" (Foster) collected three pins and was named the Most Valuable Wrestler in the division. In four years, Leichtweis has a 118-9 record and this year has 19 pins and impressed as one of the nation's finest schoolboy prospects. Last

March, Leichtweis advanced to the state finals before losing out 3-2.

Last year, Olean had 12 in the Super Section 6 championships and had three in the state. The win marked Olean's fifth straight divisional championship.

PIONEER, notching its ninth

straight division title, piled up 186 points (Division V) and had four champions and five finalists, including Tom Bennet, who was a loser in overtime in the 126 pound bout.
