Fight Teams To Compete in Saturday Event

The long Section V tournament road will begin here Saturday when Dansville Central High School wrestlers host the Livingston County tournament.

Elimination matches will begin in the Junior High gym at 1 p.m. The consolation and final rounds start at 7 p.m.

Coach Dave Hogan's DCHS matmen warmed up for the tournament which will determine Sectional entries by whipping Wellsville 26-18 in a West Central Conference match here Tuesday evening.

Dansville won six of the 12 matches, drew in two battles, forfeited the 95-lb. division and lost three decisions.

Gary Kreiley continued his undefeated streak by pinning D. Hoaghtling in the 138-lb. class. Mike Mastin turned in the only other pin of the match by downing G. Squires in the 120-lb class.

Winning decisions for Dansville were Barry Kenney in the 103-lb. class, Gary Freeman in the 112-lb. match, Louis Comardo in the 127-lb. tussle, and John Vogel in the 154-lb. event. Involved in the draws were Dick Rivkind in the 133-lb. match and Dick LeBar in the 145-lb. test. Losing by decision were Dave Whitney, John Huette and Ken Weaver.

In the preliminary matches, Dansville's junior varsity came off an easy 28-2 winner.

The Junior Varsity will travel to Nunda for a Livingston County League event this afternoon. First match is scheduled for 4:30 p.m.
