Champion Mustang Matmen Await Sectional Tournament at Hornell

Dansville Central High School's wrestling team, fresh from its victory in the Livingston County tournament here last week, will enter the Section V competition at Hornell Saturday.

Coach Dave Hogan's crew will meet opposition from Corning East, Corning West, Batavia, Hornell, Bath and Wellsville in the quarter-final and semi-final action.

Survivors of Saturday's tests

will compete the following week in the finals to be staged at Penn Yan.

Five boys won individual championships, in the county marathon here Saturday. Gaining championship trophies were Barry Kennney in the 103-lb. division, Gary Freeman in the 112-lb. class, Louis Comardo in the 217-lb. feature, Dick Rivkind in the 133-lb. battle and Gary Kreiley in the 138-lb. tussle, Dansville's sixth finalist, Dick Goho, lost out in the un-

limited division.

Two other Dansville matmen won third place honors by winning consolation matches in the evening program. They are John Vogel and Dick LeBar who were eliminated in the afternoon semi-final round.

Dansville won the county team championship by rolling up 71 points while runnerup Caledonia totaled 62. Order of finish for the other six schools competing are Livonia, 53; York, 30; Avon, 28; Geneseo, 21; Nunda, 19; Mt. Morris, 16.

A match planned yesterday at Avon was postponed and will be rescheduled later in the season.
