

Dansville High Pins Down County Wrestling Title

Five Dansville Central High School wrestlers won first place trophies in the Livingston County Tournament staged Saturday at York.

These victories, in addition to a second, two thirds and a fourth place finish, enabled Coach Dave Hogan's Mustangs to edge Livonia for the team championship.

Dansville came away with 36 points to 35 for Livonia. Caledonia, which had upset DCHS in a dual match earlier in the season, was third with 29 points. Also participating were entrants from York, Avon, Geneseo, Nunda and Mt. Morris.

The tourney's "most outstanding wrestler" trophy went to Dansville's Gary Kreiley who captured the 145-lb. championship by pinning R. Miles of Livonia in the finals. Kreiley, a defending Section V champion, is undefeated this season.

Also extending an undefeated streak was Gary Freeman who decisioned R. Stephenson of Avon in the 112-lb. finals.

The three other Dansville champions are Denny Cooper who decisioned D. Stevens of Avon in the 120-lb. finals, Dick Goho who scored a decision over previously undefeated J.

Durkee of Livonia, in the heavyweight division, and Robert Barnhart who pinned J. Kleine of Livonia in the unlimited feature of the finals.

Dick LeBar was the other Dansville matman who worked his way to the finals—only to lose by decision to W. Demsey of Geneseo in the 138-lb. class.

Winning third place points by capturing victories in the consolation competition which preceded the finals Saturday evening were Ray West who defeated M. Maloney of Geneseo in the 127-lb. class and Ron Morsch who pinned D. Hicks of York in the 133-lb. battle.

A fourth place award went to Bill Hoag, Dansville's 103-lb. entrant, who decisioned J. Wingate of Livonia before

being eliminated.

Coach Hogan's team will return to dual team competition Friday when the locals travel to Nunda for a 4:30 p.m. match. The next outing scheduled Feb. 10, a home match against Canandaigua.
