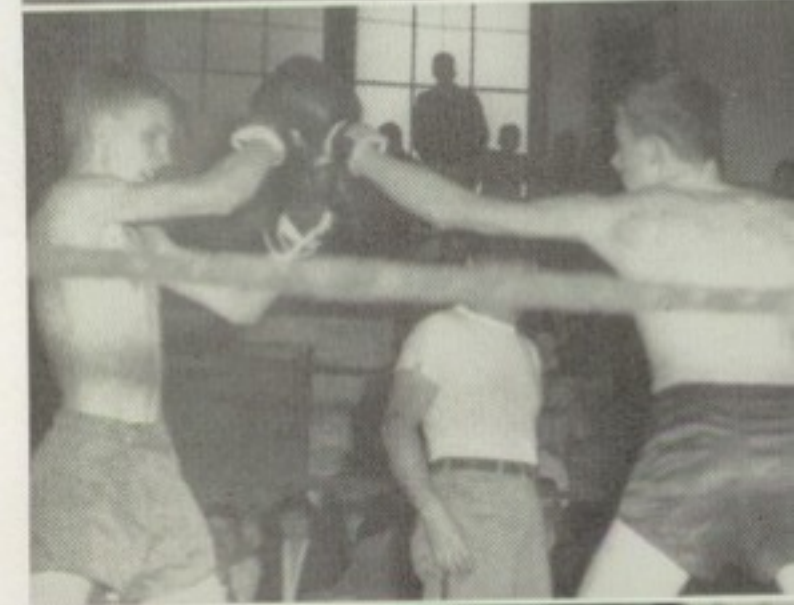


# Boxing and Wrestling

Wrestling as a varsity sport was inaugurated in the Elmira High Schools this year with a combined team representing both schools. Mr. Francis Shepherd was appointed coach. The team had a successful season for its first year; it won two meets, lost three, and tied one. A resume of the season is: Ithaca 33, EHS 10; EHS 35, Geneva 15; Ithaca 25, EHS 20; EHS 23, Geneva 16; EHS 25, Cortland 25; Cortland 27, EHS 15.

The schools split up for the sectionals at Norwich. Here Southside tied for sixth place with 30 points and Elmira Free Academy was seventh with 19 points. In an inter-school game Southside defeated the Academy 23 to 13.

At an exciting match at the Academy March 24, the Southside boxing team, coached by "Moon" Mullins, captured seven out of nine inter-school titles. It was this year that intra-mural boxing was inaugurated at Southside.
