**COLUMBUS, Ohio (UPI)**—Jacksonville upset top-ranked Kentucky, 105-109, in the NCAA Mid-East regional final.

Jones won this match as he decisioned Doug Stewart of Colonial 8-1. Stewart was from Section two, the Albany area.

In the semi-final round, Jones lost an 8-6 decision to Carl Swerdowski of Lowville, section three. Jones had a takedown but Swerdowski reversed. Jones had a reversal to lead 4-2. Swerdowski had a reversal and a predicament in the second period and Jones a reversal and it was a tie match after two periods six and six. Swerdowski rode Jones out in the third period for two points time advantage and the match.

### Thumb Injured

Jones injured his thumb in the opening period of the consolation round and was pinned at 5:42 by Lou Conway of Pearl River.

Coach Weldon Canough was well pleased by Jones' performance. "This is the first time a Canandaigua wrestler has ever won a match at state level. Don won two matches and would have placed third except for the injury to his thumb. It has been a fine year for him."

Tim Gay of East Rochester was the only Section 5 wrestler to win a championship. Gay copied the 175 pound crown with a 10-2 decision over John Ranker of Section 6; a 7-0 decision over Bill Artus of Section 11.

Gay, trailing 6-2 in the finals, reversed Rick Kovalchuk and pinned him at 5:25 for the crown.

Mike Miller of Caledonia - Mumfords took second, losing to John Cuomo of East Meadow, L.I. on a pin at 5:48 in the 145 pound class.

### 1st Round Losers

The remainder of the Section 5 wrestlers were all knocked out of contention in the opening round. Kevin Webster of Livonia lost on a pin at 2:48. Chuck Grossman of Greece - Arcadia lost on a decision 8-3 at 107 pounds.

Mike VanSchoick of Spencerport was decisioned 2-1 at 115 pounds. Roger Bubel of Spencerport was decisioned 3-1 at 123 pounds. Jeff Cohen of Cal-Mum was decisioned 8-3 at 130 pounds. Ron King of Trumansburg lost an 11-6 decision at 155 pounds.

Kurt Blank of Irondequoit was decisioned 5-2 at 165 pounds. Jim Schuster of Pembroke was decisioned 9-2 at 185 pounds. Mary Wilcox of Warsaw lost 15-6 at heavyweight and Tom Brown of Trumansburg was pinned in the first round.
