


Time to crank up the power half. (Lance Bannister at 126)



Our "Rubberman" ties another knot. (John Szucs)


The 1984-85 Wrestling Team won the Livingston County Division II championship with a league record of 10-2. Overall the team won 13 and lost 3 with two of the losses by only 5 points. Athletes in grades 8-12 blended to form a machine that outscored opponents by a combined total of 802-252 points, including two shutouts. In 161 actual matches the Indians scored 65 pins to 19 for opponents.

Eighth grader Chris Bannister (91) and ninth grader Rick Shearing (105) went undefeated in dual meet competition. In the 24-team Genesee Valley Tournament Lance Bannister won first-place crown at 112, Matt Todaro (98) finished 3rd, Kevin Brant (145) took 5th, and Ron Ikeler (119) and Chris Bannister took 6ths.

In the Livingston County Tournament L.C.S. placed third as a team and won three championships with Lance Bannister, Chris Bannister and Rick Shearing. Kevin Brant finished 2nd and Matt Todaro and Ron Ikeler 4th.

In the Class "C" sectionals Matt Todaro won a 2nd at 98, Chris and Lance Bannister 3rds and Ron Ikeler 4th. All advanced to the supersectionals.

The team lost only five seniors, but all were important to the successful season. Lance Bannister and Ron Ikeler were four-year veterans and Kevin Brant a three-year grappler. First-year seniors Steve Burger and Tom Maxian provided the team with respectable appearances at 177 and 215, but more importantly their spirit and dedication were a welcome addition.
