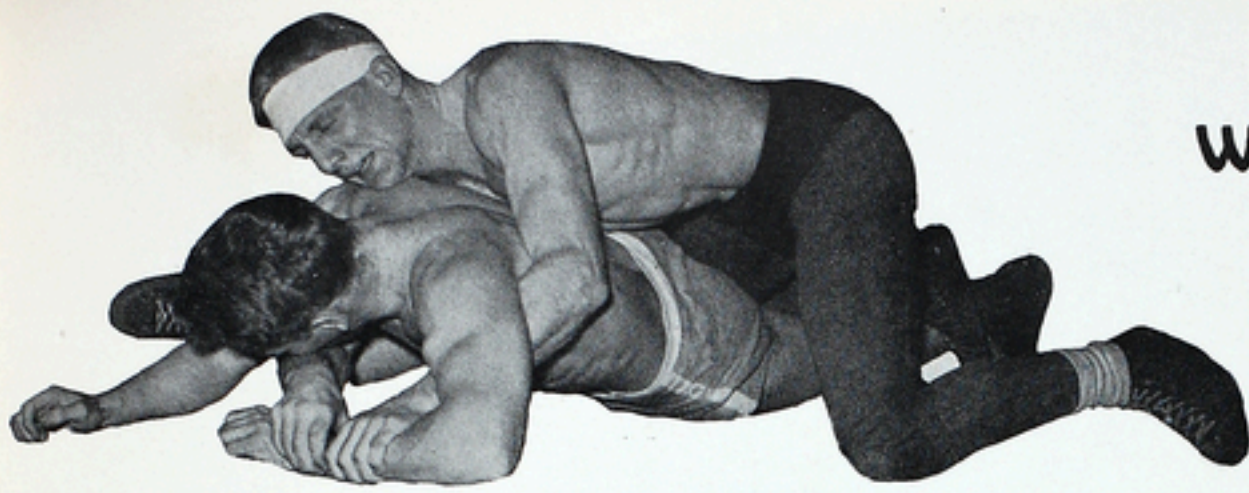

BOXING
