



Instructed by Coach David Foster, Champlain's 1947 boxing team had no intercollegiate schedule. After several months of training, elimination bouts were conducted to decide the college champions in the various weight divisions. Awarded letters and crowned champions in the different divisions were Morales, Morey, Franklin, Young, and Fazio. Peter S. Kourkoutas was manager.
