A wrestling team, worthy of comment, which has added considerably to the sport reputation of Cortland Normal School, was our representative on the mat during the season 1927.

Coached by a student instructor, John Kress, this practically veteran group of matsters defeated both collegiate and scholastic opposition, scoring four victories and suffering one defeat.

Alfred University presented strong opposition in the introductory contest, but the cleverness of our men sent them down to a 14 to 13 defeat.

The next match proved a bit too advanced for the Normalites, and Springfield Col-

lege emerged on the long end of a 20 to 6 score.

St. John's of Manlius offered no competition in a 27 to 0 victory, and the Syracuse Freshmen contributed but little more action in the next encounter. The scorers credited us with another triumph of 24 to 3.

With Alfred University as the season's final the team worked vigorously for a fourth win. This they realized as they increased their former score to 20 to 10.
