## Was There Really Doubt? Pioneer, Olean Best on Mat

As if anyone needed to be shown, perennial powers Pio-neer and Olean flexed their muscles Saturday and steamrollered competition in their respective divisions in the Section VI divisional high school wrestling championships.

Olean wrestlers won their fourth consecutive Division IV title at Depew High, winning nine of 14 weight classes and finishing second in two others. Pioneer won its eighth straight Division V crown at Arcade and placed 10 wrestlers in next week-end's state qualifier.

The winner and runner-up in each weight class of each of the section's eight divisions quali-fied for the sectional finals Friday and Saturday at Sweet Home.

Olean rolled up 2261/2 points to easily outdistance secondplace Iroquois, with 121. The Huskies' Kevin Forrest, a 126pounder who opened with a superior decision and added two pins, was named the tournament's outstanding wrestler.

PIONEER TOOK seven championships and three runner-up spots in the Division V tumble. Kyle Grunwald was one of those champs as he recorded his 71st career pin in the 138-pound class and boosted his record this year to won-25

Junior John McHugh (98) pinned all three opponents and racked up 20 points for Sweet Home as the Panthers took the Division I title at Maryvale. McHugh, 25-0, is the only unbeaten 98-pounder in the area.

Dave Young of Lancaster,

who swept three matches in the 145, was voted outstanding wrestler of the Division I meet.

HAMBURG won the Division II meet at Orchard Park and will send seven wrestlers to the sectionals, but two men from other schools raised their records to 25-0 in the competition.

Orchard Park's Bill Anderson took the outstanding wrestler prize with three pins at 215 and Dave Tundo of Frontier hammered out three decisions at 132 to remain unbeaten.

Williamsville South's Larry Cohen, 25-0, took the top wrestler award for his performance in the 112 and Clarence took the team title in the Division III outing at Clarence. The hosts took 170 points to win their first

HOST FALCONER won its third straight Division VI championship as Mike Garvey (145) took the most valuable laurels.

Tim Prince (167) captured his fourth straight divisional title with his 100th career victory as he led host Maple Grove to the Division VII crown.

Maple Grove is the only team in the last 11 years to beat Portville in the divisionals. It did it once before in 1973.

FREWSBURG'S Craig Ackley won two superior decisions and one major decision at 119 to take individual honors, but host Panama won the team crown in Division VIII.

The sectionals open at 6 PM Friday and run through Saturday night at Sweet Home. Winners in each of the 14 weight classes will advance to the state finals March 11-12 at Onondaga War Memorial in Syracuse.
