

# Iroquois Matmen Roll; Miller Is Standout

Guy Miller of host Tonawanda High School Saturday night became the first wrestler in New York State history to win five Sectional titles, although his Warriors finished second to Iroquois in the Section VI Division III championships.

Miller, who took his first Section VI crown at 91 pounds as an eighth-grader, then added 105, 112 and 119-pound titles, added the 138-pound championship by scoring a 14-4 decision over Iroquois' John Mariacher.

Otherwise, it was a disappointing night for Tonawanda, the Niagara Frontier League champion, as Iroquois wrestlers came out victorious in five other head-to-head finals against the host team.
