Note: Any wrestler with a current NYSPHSAA skin note will be referred to the onsite Dr. for screening. **The onsite Dr. may over-rule** any current note. All other wrestlers will be screened by the officials prior to stepping on the scale. If the officials see anything remotely questionable, they will refer the wrestler(s) in question to the onsite Dr.

If you had a 6<sup>th</sup> place class finisher (D1) or a 5<sup>th</sup> place class finisher (D2), you may bring them to weigh-ins in the event a wrestler gets eliminated at the scale.
