

The Hawks, who each captured a Section V Class BBB title, include seniors Matt Denning, Rob McElwain, Ron Ryan and Lucas Doty along with sophomores Matt Banks, Justin Widrig and Key McPherson.

Albion is represented by the quintet of seniors Adam Rush and Marvin Thompson, juniors Mike Donnelly and Cody Chappius and sophomore Zach Beecher.
