North Iowa advanced seven of nine wrestlers. In a crucial match at 126 pounds, Dedric Doolin of North Iowa beat Middlesex's Calvin Wood, 5-1.

Three Trojans — 177-pounder Ed Herman, who starred at Johnston High School, 190pounder Steve Eidness and heavyweight Bob Fouts, the 1972 Class AAA state wrestling champion from West Waterloo — won by falls.

Fouts turned in the quickest pin, putting away Pete Edmons of Delta of Michigan in 1 minute 18 seconds.

Also advancing for North Iowa, the runner-up in the last three tourneys, were Bill Williams at 142, Bruce Wilson at 150, and 167-pounder Dan Peterson, younger brother of Olympic medalists Dan and Ben Peterson.

Ellsworth of Iowa Falls advanced two wrestlers: Van Graham at 150 and 177-pounder Jim Bassett.

Iowa Central of Eagle Grove advanced just one man but in the process helped North Iowa's bid for the title. Mike Putney scored a forfeit victory over North Idaho's Dennis Campbell.

Dave Leon, who prepped at Valley of West Des Moines, was beaten, 14-2, by Leon Younger of Colby, Kan., at 126. Leon is wrestling for Arizona Western of Mesa, Ariz.
