



NCCC dominates Alfred State

ALFRED—The NCCC Trail Blazers traveled to Alfred State on Friday Dec. 11 seeking another Conference win. With both teams currently 1-0 in their conference, NCCC was able to deliver a 34 to 12 victory over the Pioneers.

The Trail Blazers had three pins on the night coming from sophomore Shay Shive with a fall of 2:07 over Darren Whittall, sophomore Richard Dawson who earned a fall in just 1:45 over Dan Dwyer, and freshman Matt Johnson who earned his second consecutive conference match by pin fall in 3:51 over Zach Rause. “It was nice to have Richard Dawson return and compete well after missing last week’s tournament with a knee injury,” said Head Coach Eric Knuutila.

The Trail Blazers also earned a decision at the 133-pound weight class from sophomore and captain Dan Audy who posted a 6-2 decision. Rocco Rosso, Troy Ireland, and Paul Ciaramella also collected victories for the Trail Blazers.

The Pioneers’ biggest highlight of the night came from 141-pounder Eric Sheddon who defeated Tim Coughlin by pin fall at 2:46. Eric Giles and Dan Steiger also won decisions for the Pioneers.

NCCC has now improved to 2-0 in the Conference and 3-1 overall. □
