21st Annual NHSCA Senior Nationals – March 25th-28th

The truest National Championship in any high school sport in America. The Senior Nationals has a profile and history like no other event. At the 2009 NCAA DI National Tournament, 9 of 10 Champions and 74 of the 80 NCAA All Americans wrestled in this event when they were HS seniors. Last year's field alone boasted 16-4x state champions, 46-3x state champions over 100-2x state champions and over 200-1x state champions. The 28 finalists in the event sported 54 individual state or national prep titles. More than 200 wrestlers that competed in last year's event accepted scholarship offers and signed with colleges and universities throughout the country. Must be a High School State Champion or Runner-Up to qualify (except CA (top 8), IN, NJ, & NY (top 4)).

6th Annual NHSCA High School Junior Nationals - March 23rd-26th

In 2009, the NHSCA Junior Nationals brought in more than 700 wrestlers for a great display of talent. At the Junior Nationals there were 789 entries from 43 different states including 173 State Champions and 545 state place-winners. 12 of the 14 champions from the 2009 event signed college scholarships with Division I schools in the early signing period. This event remains open to every junior; the multiple-time state champion and dark horse alike and has been proven to be the toughest national challenge for high school wrestlers in the country. Don't miss your chance to be a part of it! Top 8 are All-Americans & qualify for Senior Nationals in 2011.

5th Annual NHSCA High School Sophomore Nationals - March 23rd-26th

Modeled after the HS Junior Nationals the 2009 High School Sophomore Nationals produced some unbelievable talent that is sure to make major waves at the next level. Competing in last year's event was a field of 581 wrestlers from 42 different states. 53 of them had already won a state title and 209 of them had placed in their respective state tournament. Over 70% of the entries were state champions, state place finishers, or state qualifiers from their home state. Every sophomore in the United States has been invited to compete in this event. Don't miss your shot!

4th Annual NHSCA High School Freshman Nationals - March 23rd-26th

The Freshman Nationals in only its 3rd year attracted 420 competitors from 40 different states; 35 state champions and 76 state place-winners. Every Freshman in the country is invited to compete in this event. This is a tremendous opportunity for every serious 9th grade wrestler. Don't miss your chance to take your place among the wrestling legends that have proven their abilities at this event.

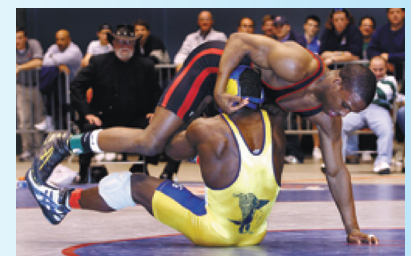
Finals will be broadcasted live through 65 million homes on the High School Television Network.
