


This year, the Institute wrestling team made great strides in regaining the place of prominence that it held at one time in inter-collegiate mat circles.

Tutored by new coach Earl Fuller, and sparked by team captain Ken Christian, the tusslers had a very successful season in competition with some of its strongest pre-war rivals.

Included in the 1948-49 schedule were meets with Ontario Agricultural College, University of Buffalo, Case Institute of Technology, Alfred University, Western Reserve University, Akron College, St. Lawrence University, and Baldwin Wallace College. New on the Techmen's schedule this year were Akron College and Western Reserve. With four wins, four losses, and a tie, the boys had a far more impressive record than during the 1947-48 season.
