



# Assemblyman Morelle Amends Fairness In Competition Legislation NYSWCA Registers A Memorandum Of Support

#### Memo in Support of Amended Bill A.2162-A (Morelle)

The New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NY SPHSAA) policies for organizing state championship competition is fundamentally flawed and will remain so as long as qualifying events, by design, do not give competitors an equal chance to qualify for state competition. This policy is particularly unjust where competitors are not organized for competition within the common five school population classifications or where there is no statewide standard of measure (like qualifying times) to compensate for the wildly unequal qualifying events.

Historically, and apparently in the interest of fairness, the NYSPHSAA has demonstrated a willingness to make adjustments to qualifying tournaments for state competition for team sports. In Boys Ice Hockey, an additional entry is allowed for the section with greatest number of teams. In football, the two smallest sections (7 & 10) have been merged and a team from a third section (3) was added to the grouping - apparently to even up the competition.

The same can not be said for all the individual sports.

While athletes in individual sports like swimming and track and field still must qualify for state competition through unfair sectional events with disproportionate numbers of competitors, at least in these individual sports additional deserving athletes can qualify for the state championship event by meeting a statewide standard time/distance.

Of the remaining individual sports like, bowling, golf, tennis, and gymnastics - while each section sends the same number of qualifiers to the state tournament regardless of the number of competitors in the section - each section at least gets to send multiple-entries. The multiple-entry format increases participation but the policy still remains unfair in that competitors are not afforded a similar chance to qualify. Take for example golf - a section with 11 schools gets to send 9 golfers to the state tournament while a section eight times bigger, with 77 schools, also gets 9 entries.

But by far, the most unfair policy of all is the NYSPHSAA policy governing the State Wrestling Tournament. There, multipleentry is not permitted. Only one entry is allowed to advance to state competition regardless of the number of competitors in each section. Additional entries are not allowed regardless of the fact that one section has fifty teams competing while another section has two.

The NYSPHSAA reacted to the initial draft of A.2162 with a negative campaign among school superintendents and athletic directors claiming the legislation would doom high school athletics, harm academic achievement, and impose unbearable costs on school districts.

While these claims are exaggerations, distortions, and falsehoods - it seems more prudent at this point to narrow the focus of A.2162 in order to address those sports and athletes most adversely affected by the NYSPHSAA's unfair competition policies.

The amendment would change the bill by affecting only individual sports not included in the NYSPHSAA's five class system or sports absent an "equalizer."

Sports affected by A.2162 would be wrestling, bowling, golf, tennis, and possibly gymnastics.

# NYSPHSAA Committee Recommends Wildcards For State Tournament Byes Would be Filled-In For 2007 Tournament

The NYSPHSAA Wrestling Committee voted last Thursday to "fill-in the byes on the bracket by using wildcards" for the 2007 New York State Wrestling Tournament.

The proposal, which must be approved by the Championship Committee and the Executive Committee, uses certain criteria to select 4 additional wrestlers per weight class from across the state to compete in the state tournament. There is no expansion of the state tournament beyond the current twodivision 16-man bracket.

The proposed criteria for selecting wildcard entries, which may be revised, includes: placing 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in current sectionals, placement in previous state tournaments, career victories, placement in previous sectional tournaments, and "power points" for wrestlers from the "stronger sections". The power points awarded wrestlers from stronger sections will be based on the history of the section's team performance in past state tournaments.

#### NYSWCA Comment

This action by the NYSPHSAA Wrestling Committee is a

step in the right direction but falls far short of the goal to have a state tournament of excellence - a state tournament designed to be as fair and competitive as possible.

Granted, under this proposal, at least some deserving wrestlers who have been excluded from the state tournament in the past would be considered for entry. Many others however will still be denied a fair opportunity to qualify.

While the wildcard proposal will add 60 wrestlers to each division in the state tournament, New York will continue to stand out as the state tournament with the fewest number of participants (per number of wrestling programs) in the country. It remains as the only state in the country without true multiple-entry based on proportionality or equal sections.

Still, this is an improvement over what we currently have. To be sure, there are important details to be worked out and revisions to be made but it represents a beginning.

It is not however, the fundamental reform that so many coaches across the state would like to see.

# Coaches Association Gains Access To NYSPHSAA Meetings

Prompted by a request from the NYS Wrestling Coaches Association's executive director, the New York State Committee on Open Governments recently issued an opinion stating that the New York State Public High School Athletic Association (NYSPHSAA) is "a public body that falls within the requirements of the Open Meetings Law".

The opinion was requested after the NYSPHSAA Coordinator for Wrestling barred the NYS Wrestling Coaches Association from attending the state wrestling committee meeting last May where changes in the New York State Wrestling Tournament were to be proposed.

Shortly after the opinion was issued, the Coaches Association was personally invited to the September meeting of the NYSPHSAA Wrestling Committee.

The NYS Wrestling Coaches Association is the leading advocate for reforming the NYS Wrestling Tournament. The Association is campaigning for a multiple-entry state tournament organized in a way that provides a fair opportunity for wrestlers to qualify for the state tournament. New York is the only state in the union that limits their state wrestling tournament to a single entry per division and it's one of just two states that doesn't organize its qualifying tournaments with equal numbers of competitors. The other state, California, compensates for their uneven qualifying events by sending multiple entries to their state tournaments based on the number of competitors in the respective qualifiers.

### Fast Facts About The New York State Wrestling Tournament

Nebraska has 218 wrestling programs, a multiple-entry state tournament with 896 wrestlers, and a paid attendance of 46,403. New York has 550 wrestling programs. It is the only state in the country with a single-entry tournament. It currently has just 360 wrestlers and a paid attendance of 17,323.


