HOW TO FOLLOW TOURNAMENT WRESTLING

If you are new to wrestling, the following guidelines will help you follow the progress of a bout and the tournament.

A wrestling bout is six minutes long; divided into three periods, each lasting two minutes.

The first period of each bout starts from a standing position. The second and third periods begin on the mat, contestants alternating in the top position at the beginning of each period.

A pin which ends the bout, occurs when a wrestler holds any part of his opponent's shoulders or area of both scapulas to the mat for two seconds. When the bout goes the full six minutes, the wrestler with the highest score wins the bout by a decision.

In tournament wrestling, when no decision is met (a tie) in regulation time, the bout goes into overtime of one, three-minute period. In the event of a tie after the overtime ends, a jury of two judges and the referee select the winner by written ballot.

A default occurs when a wrestler is unable to continue because of injury. In the event of a default or forfeit, the winning wrestler earns a pin point as well as an advancement point for his team.

Penalties are awarded by the referee under a point system for stalling, illegal holds and technical violations.

HOW TO SCORE AN INDIVIDUAL MATCH

TAKE DOWN	taking opponent to the mat with advantage	2 points
ESCAPE	defensive wrestler gaining neutral position	1 points
REVERSAL	defensive comes from underneath, gains control of his opponent on the mat	2 points
PREDICAMENT	offensive wrestler has his opponent in a pinning situation	2 points
NEAR FALL	when criteria for predicament is uninterrupted for five seconds	3 points
TIME ADVANTAGE -	while wrestler is in control for one minute more than his opponent	1 point
