# Brighton, ER wrestlers swap weight classes

Brighton's Otha Davidson and East Rochester's D.J. Williams provided Section 5's biggest wrestling surprise when they switched weight classes last weekend.

Davidson was last year's Super-Sectionals 215-pound champion. Williams finshed fourth at the state championships last year after winning the SuperSectionals 250 crown.

They tied, 2-2, during Brighton's Monroe County Division 2 dual meet victory over ER. When Davidson decided to move up, Williams went down.

"We didn't get together and decide what to do, but we did agree to keep each other appraised," said Brighton Coach Mark Hoyt.

Hoyt said he called Whitcomb about a week ago to tell him that Davidson was moving up. Williams has never beaten Davidson.

Rumors that Davidson, who wrestled at about 225 pounds last weekend, would go up have been circulating since he struggled to win the

Monroe County 215 title.

"I was having problems with small colds and I started to feel too weak," said Davidson. "At the counties I was terrible. I ran into some tough matches early and just didn't do well. Coach (Hoyt) and I had talked about it before and we decided it would be the best thing."

Davidson (30-1-1) is ranked No. 4

in the state at 215 by New York Wrestling News and Williams (26-0-2) is No. 3 at 250.

Batavia's Buddy Cabrera, who won the Class A sectional 215 title on Saturday, took Davidson into overtime in the county final before Davidson won on referee's criteria beacuse he scored one more takedown.

Williams won the sectional Class

C 215 title on Saturday.

Jamie Huntington of Whitehall (Section 2) handed Davidson his only defeat, 8-1, during a December tournament and is ranked No. 3 in the state at 215.

"He had a good day and I had a

bad day," Davidson said.

Kevin Brinkworth of Williamsville South (Sec. 6), last year's state 215 runner-up, is No. 1. He defeated Davidson in last year's state quarterfinals then beat Huntington in the state semifinals.

Todd Schaffer of Vestal (Sec. 4), one of the state's top 215-pounders last season, is ranked No. 1 at 250. No. 2 Jamie Call of Indian River (Sec. 3) placed third at 250 at last year's state championships.

## More wrestling

Spencerport successfully defended its Class A sectional wrestling team title by outpointing Brighton, 177-160½, at Rush-Henrietta.

The Barons are ranked No. 4 in the New York State Sports Writers Association poll. The Rangers are No. 13 and third-place Greece Athena is ranked 20th.

All four Spencerport wrestlers who advanced to the finals won sectional championships.

 Palmyra-Macedon succesfully defended its Class B team championship by outpointing runner-up Waterloo, 196-1571/2.

Chris Francis led Pal-Mac by defending his 167-pound sectional

pinned Francis championship. Bath's Ryan Emo 58 seconds into

their championship bout. The Red Raiders, ranked No. 21

in the state poll, placed eight wrestlers in the finals. Pete Cooper defeated Waterloo's Darrell Travers, 10-1, to capture the 91 title, Chris Van Gorden pinned North Rose-Wolcott's Bruce Wall at 1:32 of their 145-pound final and Ron Schommer defeated Newark's Jack Fisher, 5-3, at 250.

Victor's Casey Lamb defended his 177 sectional crown with a 3-2 victory over Wayne's Bill Swarthout.

 East Rochester defended its Class C team championship at Geneseo High School. The Bombers put seven wrestlers in the finals and crowned three champions to outpoint runner-up Marion, 197-135.

Tim Donahue of LeRoy scored a major upset when he pinned ER's Alex Glaza at 1:31 of their 145 championship bout. Donahue finished fourth in the Livingston County League tournament.

 Class D team champion Red Creek advanced six wrestlers to the finals and four won sectional titles.

Don Henner pinned Alfred-Almond's Ryan McMichael at 1:40 of their 98 final, Chad Acome defeated Canisteo's Jamie Kneale, 12-2, to capture the 119 title, Mike Mc-Intyre pinned Pavilion's Roger Cosamino at 2:54 of the 126 final and Bill Walsh pinned Hammondsport's Steve Pulver at 3:21 of their 145 bout.

Undefeated Kenny Porter of runner-up Alfred-Almond took the first step toward defending his state 138-pound crown when he pinned Fillmore's Justin Stone at 1:21 of their final.
