Pittsford's Wallman Lone Repeater

Ray Wallman, Pittsford's tough 133-pound champion, is the lone repeater on the 1964 Times-Union All-County Wrestling Team announced today.

A senior, Wallman made the team a year ago when he won the county's 127-pound title.

EASTRIDGE, champion of the Monroe County League, is one of four schools to place two wrestlers on the team. Others include Webster, Irondequoit and Gates-Chili. Hilton, Pittsford, Brighton and tournament champion East Rochester all placed one.

The team is comprised of six underclassmen— including sophomores Lloyd Swart of Eastridge (95), Tom Lynch of Gates-Chili (103) and John Buttrill of Brighton (165). Juniors are Bruce Rolland of Webster (unlimited), Larry DiCiantis of East Rochester (145) and Tom Borshoff of Irondequoit (112).

The remainder of the team is made up of seniors Jim Hosenfeld of Webster (154), Keith Holderness of Eastridge (120), Larry Sinbox of Gates-Chili (127), Jay Whipple of Irondequoit (138), Dick Miller of Hilton (180) and Wallman.

Thumbnail Sketches:

95—Lloyd Swart (Eastridge)—Second year on varsity, he compiled 12-3 dual meet record... won Eastridge Holiday Invitational Tournament... has two-year overall record of 26-10... played freshman football and hopes to go to college and major in science.

103—Tom Lynch (Gates-Chili)—Finished undefeated this year winning 12 and tying 2... was 8-2 as a freshman... in two years on mats, he has won 22 bouts while losing just three and tying two.

112—Tom Borshoff (Irondequoit)—Once-beaten this year, Tom has two-year record of 38-3... runner-up at 95 in county last year, he won Auburn Invitational this year as well as Greco Roman and Freestyle events sponsored by Irondequoit Recreation Dept... eyes liberal arts education at Brockport State.

120—Keith Holderness (Eastridge)—Won 14 dual meet bouts this year, 12-1-1 last year and 44-3-1 overall... twice Eastridge Holiday Invitational champion and county runner-up last year... won Greco Roman and Freestyle events
