Grunwald Leads Mat Advance

Kyle Grunwald, protective mask and all, nevertheless defeated four opponents en route to the most valuable wrestler award Saturday in the Section VI Intersectional Qualifier at Sweet Home High School.

Grunwald, of Pioneer High School in Arcade, the defending state titlist in the 132-pound division, raised his season record to 29-0 by stopping Calvin Crippen of Sweet Home, 4-0, in the final match.
