

Cavayero Colonials' king

OSWEGO — Brockport State picked up five individual crowns yesterday and waltzed to the State University of New York Athletic Conference wrestling title for the fourth straight year as SUNY-Binghamton finished fourth.

Colonial freshman Steve Cavayero breezed to the 142-pound crown, but teammates Matt Ouimet and Mark Palombo were ousted in the finals.

Ouimet, a freshman from Unatego, nearly became the tourney's biggest spoiler. He was unseeded at 150, but jumped to a 7-1 lead against top-seeded Greg Nettleton of Geneseo State in the semis and coasted to a 10-6 triumph. Brockport's Bob Brenton proved too strong in the finals, though.

Union-Endicott grad Palombo failed to defend his 158-pound crown when Cortland State's Rick Armstrong (from Whitney Point) prevailed, 6-1, using a front headlock to control Palombo.

Other Colonials who placed were Mike Carra, third at 167; Bill Collado, fourth at 118; and Jason Sokoloff, fourth at 126.

Maine-Endwell product Jim Hauptfleisch, who won the heavyweight crown for Oswego State in 1975 but has been plagued with a bad knee since, couldn't cope with defending champ Mackey Tyndall of Brockport. Tyndall, who led 6-2 when he pinned Hauptfleisch, was named as Outstanding Wrestler.

Cortland 118-pounder Bob Eddy (from Spencer-VanEtten) bowed to Brockport's Jerry Goodfellow in the finals.

Oneonta State's Rick VanNoy won the 167-pound title in overtime and then was taken to a local hospital because of exhaustion.
