The same difficulty which hampered the efforts of the fencing team, lack of manpower, sabotaged the wrestlers in 1942. At the outset there were only six men on the
squad to wrestle in seven weight classes. Matches were lost to Alfred and Rochester
Mechanics Institute. Then the team completely disintegrated. One man broke a rib
and another was forced to withdraw from competition to devote more time to his,
studies. As a result, coach Wilson had only four men to wrestle in seven weight
classes. Further competition under these conditions was impossible. The matches at
Toronto and at Alfred and the home finale against Case had to be cancelled.
