The wrestling squad of 1963-64 has proved itself to be another in the long line of championship teams. Completely dominating its field, our team has its 114 consecutive victory and its 7th sectional title. The team is shooting for the national mark of 136 consecutive victories, which should be reached in the 1966-67 season.

Our squad has produced several undefeated wrestlers during league competition. Included in this highly selective group of wrestlers are: Rod and Ray Rudich and Todd DuMoulin. The league competition opened with East Aurora, and Iroquois won its one hundredth match. The matches became tougher as the season flew by. Although Arcade and Orchard Park were considered the toughest rivals the team faced, the season ended with a 15-0 record.

The sectionals this year were reduced to virtually a 3-way battle between Iroquois, Maryvale and Niagara-Wheatfield. The sectional champs—Rod Rudich, Russ Brookman, and Timm DuMoulin—scored victories in their respective weight classes as Iroquois retained its sectional crown.
