Winners of the Canisteo and Andover tournaments will be matched next Wednesday at Canisteo to decide entries in the semi-finals of the Section 5 Class B event at Victor.

Seven schools will have entries in the "A" events at Corning. This list includes: Hornell, Dansville, Bath, Wellsville, the two Cornings and Batavia.

Competing at Canisteo today will be Addison, Avoca, Arkport, Campbell, Canisteo, Savona and Hammondsport.

At least six schools will have entries at the Andover tournament. The field includes Alfred-Almond, Cuba, Fillmore, Bolivar, Belmont and Andover.

Cuba won the Allegany County league title with Alfred-Almond and Fillmore close behind. These three are expected to wage the major scramble for the individual titles today.

Corning West won the area "A" conference title although held to a draw in its one meeting with Dansville. East in turn handed Dansville its only defeat in the last two years.

Observers look for some outstanding contests in all the tournaments. These are primarily individual tournaments. And al-

most every school has at least one or two boys with undefeated records and something close to this.

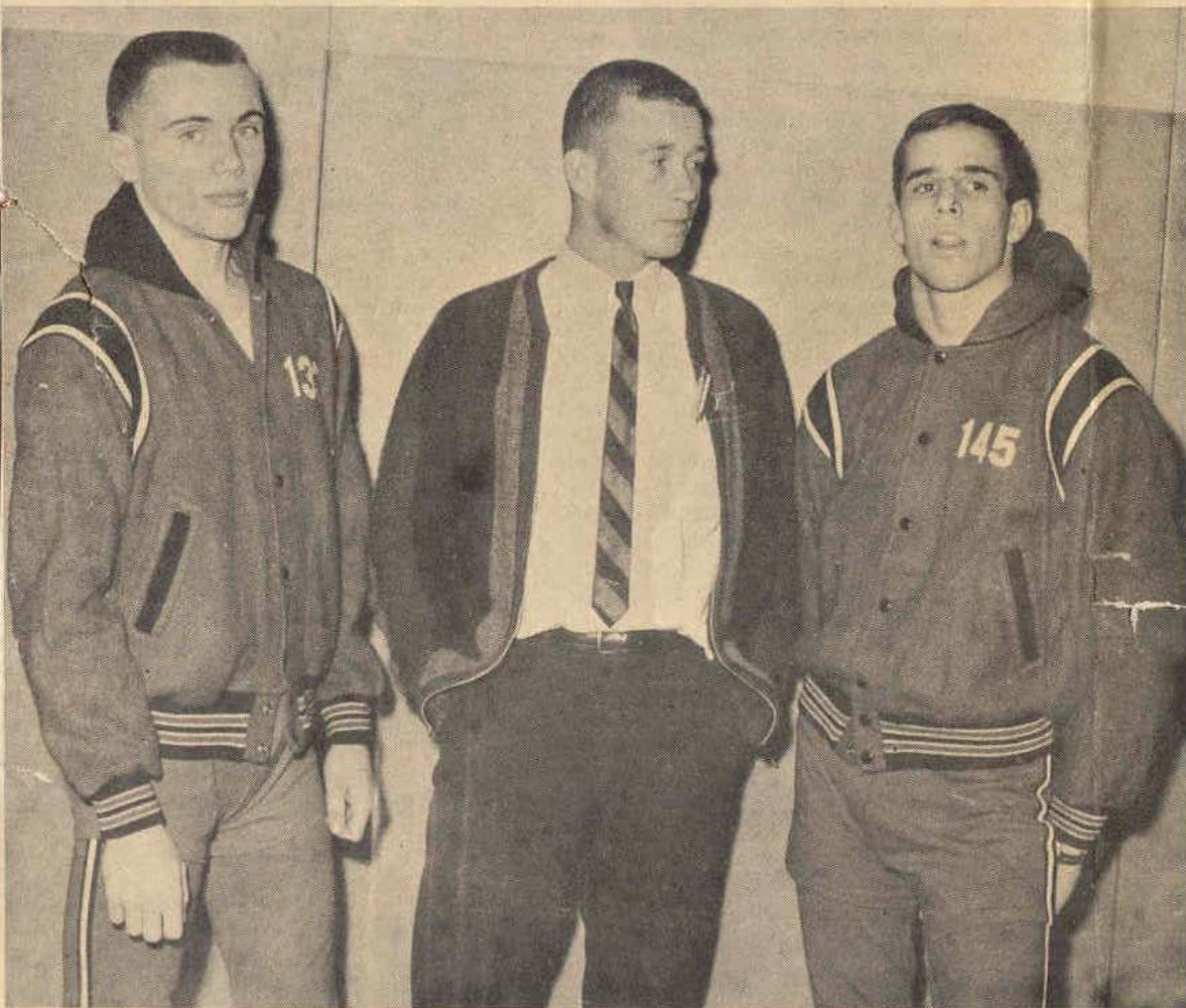
