Potsdam's Tony Peraza, defending
SUNYAC 142-pound champ dropped his
semi-final match on a controversial 5-4
decision to the eventual champion, and
then suffered another one point loss in
the consolation round in one of the
tournament's major upsets.
Potsdam will compete in the New
York State Intercollegiate cham-

pionships at Rochester Tech next weekend, and then selected members of the Bear squad will travel to Wilkes College in Pennsylvania for the NCAA College Division III tournament on March 1 and 2.
