Terry Mather was victim of a mis-calculated takedown and was decisioned by Hobart's Bob Simmons 6-3 but Jim Alessi, wrestling at 177, evened the score with a 5-0 win over John Brackett of Hobart. Steve Tiza, ahead at the time, was disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct, so Hobart's Cluck Dima carted home the heavyweight honors for the day.
