Section 4 Wrestling Tournament

Early rounds produce surprises

One unbeaten wrestler and a pair of once-beaters fell by the wayside during last night's quarterfinal bouts at the Section 4 Wrestling Tournament.

Vestal High was the site of yesterday's first two rounds, but today's bouts will be held at the SUNY-Binghamton men's gym.

A full house at Vestal saw four top candidates fall by the wayside as Spencer-Van Etten's Mark Eddy ended a 31-bout unbeaten streak by Johnson City's Jim Lateer at 98 pounds, Unatego's Dave Peterson stopped once-beaten Charlie Wiles of Owego at 155, and Maine-Endwell's Carmen Gumble upset Deposit's once-beaten Scott Elinsky at 126.

Lateer, who had pinned almost everyone he faced in going 30-0-1, was never in the hunt against Eddy, who rolled to a 25-6 win and upped his record to 24-2.

Elinsky, who most observers felt would advance to the finals against Ithaca's Dave Turco (who handed him his only previous loss this season), bowed 12-8 to the scrappy Gumble, who was 21-6 going into the bout. Turco, meantime, had to fight off a late takedown try to secure a 10-8 win over three-time Elinsky victim Ted Webb of Bainbridge-Guilford.

Peterson, now peaking after a mid-season injury, carried a 16-6 record against Wiles (25-1) and dominated the action, blanking the Owego ace 5-0.

There are still plenty of glittering records left for today's 2 o'clock semifinals, including Windsor's Glen Gould at 98 (28-0-1), Sidney's Dennis Voltz at 105 (25-1), Walton's Tim Grehory at 138 (29-0-1), Sherburne-Earlville's Scott Campbell at 145 (29-1), Deposit's Roy Lobbell at 155 (29-1) and Oneonta's Blake Bader at 167 (30-1).

Wrestling begins today with wrestlebacks at

noon — although it was decided last night that the wrestlebacks would extend only to fifth place.

That means the losers of today's 2 o'clock semifinal bouts will wrestle off for third place in the consolation finals at 6 p.m. The championship bouts are slated for 7:30.

Yesterday's overflow crowd, which started spilling over from the bleachers to the hallways before the tournament was an hour old, fortified the arguments of those who insist the tournament belongs in Triple Cities — but it also served to underline the fact that SUNY-Binghamton needs to open its doors for more than just one day.

Earlier in the week, Vestal coach Al Packer had fretted over the tournament arrangements, noting "We really don't have the locker room space," and yesterday he took a personal day off from school to help put the mats down and oversee operations. To his credit and the school's, things ran very smoothly.
