# Braves Gain 7 Semi-Final Spots

Quarter-final round of the Section 5 Finger Lakes wrestle-offs found the Canandaigua Academy Braves grabbing seven spots for the semi-finals next Saturday at Ben Franklin High School in Rochester.

In addition to the seven Braves, Geneva High gained four and Newark one. Batavia, the remaining school, failed to gain a spot.

The 12 Finger Lakes Section 5 representatives will meet the Southern Tier champs next Saturday. The winners of this meeting will then go against the 12 winners from the Monroe County-Rochester City encounter, in the finals at 8.

Gaining the chance to represent the Finger Lakes area for Canandaigua Academy were:

Yosef Adane at 103 pounds, Tony Addante at 120 pounds, Rick Tripodi at 133, Gregg Thomas at 138, Gary Carpenter at 145, Dick Davis at 165 and Charlie Carmel at 180 pounds.

Representing Geneva High will be Peter Achilles at 95 pounds, Bill Achilles at 127 pounds, Dave Van Gordon at 154 and Don Jones at unlimited.

Newark's lone entrant will be Joe Lawrence at 112 pounds.

## Evening Highlight

The most exciting match of the evening came at the 127-pound weight where CA's Ralph Herzog and Bill Achilles, of Geneva battled it out. So perfectly are the boys matched that not a point had been scored in the regulation 3 periods. The match went into overtime which requires two 1-minute periods. In the first period, Herzog gained a point on an escape just as the buzzer sounded.

In the second period, Herzog had ridden Achilles until the final three seconds when Achilles gained a reversal as the buzzer sounded to win the match 2-1.

It was the third meeting for the two boys, the first ending in a draw, the second a win for Herzog and this time a win for Achilles.

CA went into the finals with

11 out of 12 wrestlers. Bill Barnum was defeated by Joe Lawrence of Newark 8-3 in the afternoon matches.

Bill Foley, CA's 95-pound entrant lost a 10-0 decision to Geneva's Pete Achilles in the opening match of the evening.

## Adane Wins

Then at the 103-pound weight, Yosef Adane, CA's foreign exchange student from Ethiopia, pinned Jim Baker of Batavia at 2:32 to gain the semi-finals.

Joe Lawrence of Newark became the 112-pound winner when he shaded Karl Marchenese of Geneva High, 8-7. The boys had 7 points each but Lawrence had time advantage for a point and the match.

At 120 pounds, Tony Addante, late year's Section 5 112-pound champ, rolled up an 11-1 decision over Carl Frederickson of Newark. Addante had beaten Dick Schading of Geneva in the elimination bout in the afternoon.

Bill Achilles won the 127-pound weight with his overtime win over Herzog. Herzog had beaten Pat Palmer of Batavia 5-2 in the elimination round.

## Display Of Speed

At 133 pounds, Rick Tripodi decisioned Pat Stamp of Batavia, 10-0, in a terrific display of speed. The Batavia boy never had a chance to get going. Tripodi had pinned John Elzofon of Newark and Stamp had decisioned Phil Johnson of Geneva to gain the finals.

At 138 pounds, Greg Thomas of CA won a 3-0 decision over Bob Campbell of Newark. Thomas had decisioned his old rival, Dick Collins of Geneva, 5-3, in the afternoon in a tough match. Campbell had decisioned Pat Hickey of Batavia, 14-4.

At 145 pounds, Gary Carpenter of CA gained a 3-0 decision over Bruce Davie of Geneva. Carpenter had a bye in the afternoon while Davie had decisioned Ray Clauss of Batavia 2-0.

## Renewed Rivalry

The 154 pound class became another meeting between Dave VanGordon of Geneva and Bob Dixon of CA. Van Gordon was the winner, getting a 9-0 deci-

sion. This was the third meeting of these two boys with VanGordon winning all. The crowd gave them a terrific hand at the end of the match which was a thriller despite the score.

VanGordon had a bye and Dixon had pinned Mike Palmer of Batavia in the afternoon.

The 165-pound class saw CA's Dick Davis decision Geneva's Wayne Klue, 3-0, in a hard-fought contest.

Davis had beaten Tim DeJohn 13-0 in the afternoon while Klue had decisioned Pat Lafanara of Batavia 5-2.

At 180 pounds a tigerish Charlie Carmel pinned Jack Smith of Newark in 4:40, rolling to 10 points before the pin. In the afternoon, Carmel had decisioned Bryan Whittaker of Geneva and Smith had decisioned Bob Puleo of Batavia.

In the unlimited class, Don Jones of Geneva pinned Gary Marvin of CA at 5:41 in a thrilling contest. It was the third meeting for these two boys with Jones getting all three wins.
