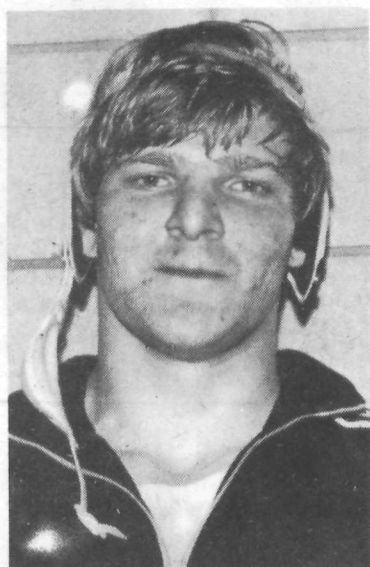

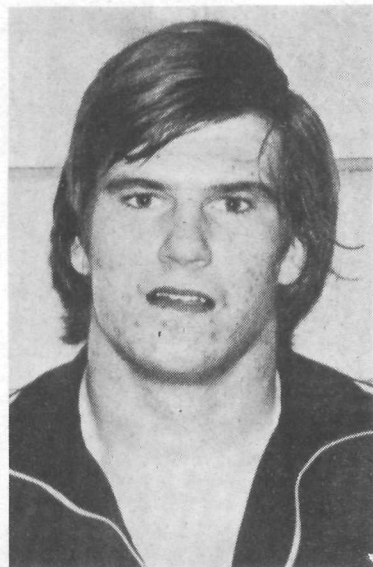
## Three wrestlers make All-Region team

Monroe Community College is pleased to announce that three of its wrestlers have been chosen as Region III All-Star selections. They are: 1979 Region III All-Star Len Barber (158 lbs.); freshman Paul Gibson (190 lbs.) from Irondequoit and freshman Joe D'Acquisto (6'5"-257 lbs.) at heavy-weight.

These athletes will be members of the 10 man Region III All-Star team which will compete against the New York City area Region XV All-Star team in their annual dual meet contest. The site of this years All-Star match is Broome Community College commencing at 1:00 P.M. on Sunday, January 27.

These wrestlers have distinguished themselves athletically on many different occasions. Barber's credentials are incredible! His 1978-79 overall record was 34-6 and so far this season he has accumulated a 15-1-1 record. He is a two time Corning Invitational Wrestling Champion; two time Niagara Invitational Champion; the 1979 Brockport Open Champion; the 1979 Grand Rapids Invitational Runner-up and the 1979 Region III 158 pound Champion. Len has also distinguished himself with 3 out of 3 impressive victories over Todd Sumpter of Westchester Community College who was last year's 1979 National Junior College Wrestling Champion.

Paul Gibson in his first year has accumulated a record of 13-4 with 9 pins. In the 1979 Brockport Open Wrestling Tournament he placed third losing only to Syracuse University's Captain Steve Rosa by a score of 3-2. Paul also captured the 1979 Niagara Invitational Wrestling Championship at 190 pounds and was runner-up in the prestigious 1979 Grand Rapids Wrestling Tournament losing a close and controversial 9-7 decision in the finals.

Joe D'Acquisto to date has compiled an overall record of 16-2. Fifteen of his 16 victories have been by falls, and his 2 losses consisted of an injury default and an early season loss to a University of Syracuse wrestler. Joe began the season by capturing third place honors in the Brockport Open. He then pinned his way to championship titles in

both the Corning Invitational Wrestling Tournament and the Niagara Invitational Wrestling Tournament. At Corning he won the trophy for the most pins in the

least amount of time. Only an ankle injury prevented him from a trip to the finals at the Grand Rapids Invitational Wrestling Tournament.

## College sets policy for emergency snow closings

Ever wake up in the morning for your 8 a.m. class, and after dressing or showering and looking outside, know you'll need a bobsled or snowmobile to get to school on time (if at all)? Then give the radio a listen.

WHAM (1180) is the official station for information on all

emergency college closings. WHAM is the first to be notified by the College, usually no later than 6:30 a.m. All other stations do carry the information, but at later times.

If Continuing Education Classes are to be cancelled, all

radio stations will be notified by 3 p.m. When the college is closed all personnel except Security and Maintenance are excused from reporting. If college classes are cancelled all personnel, except the teaching faculty, will report to work.
