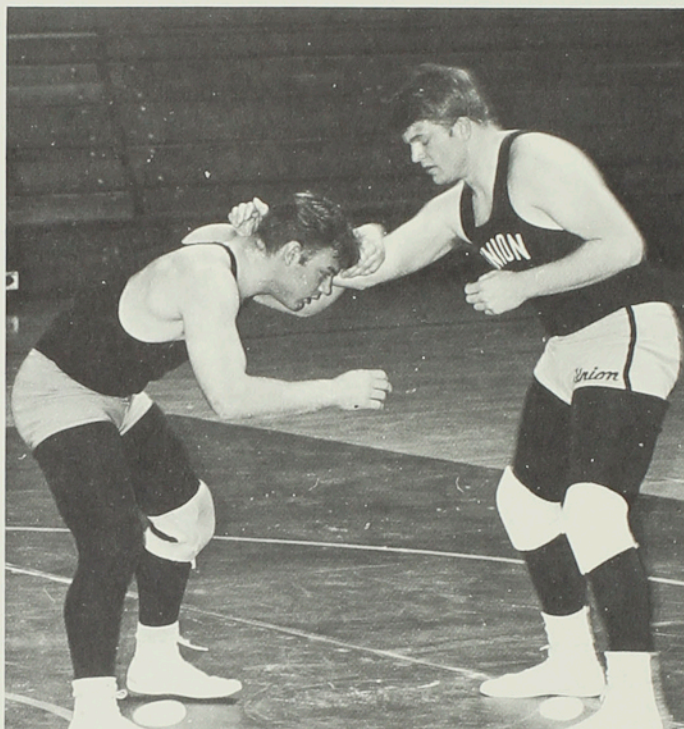


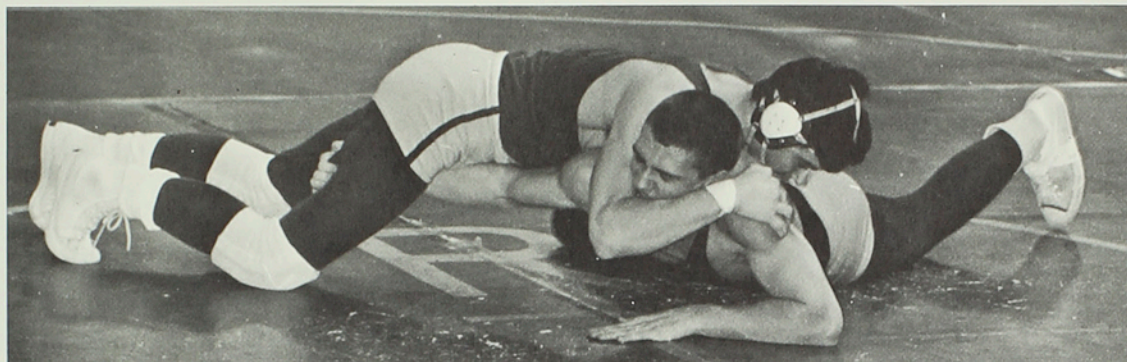

University of Rochester Yellowjackets
1966-1967 Wrestling



Led by Captain Elliot Katz, the varsity wrestling team started the season off with a healthy 26 to 13 victory over the University of Toronto. The remainder of the season proved to be generally disappointing, though, as the matmen were the victims of a series of defeats at the hands of skillful and consistently highly competitive opponents.

In the Allegheny meet at Meadville, Pennsylvania, the Yellowjackets lost a hard-fought, 17 to 14 battle that was eventually to be decided in the final match of the day. Four days later, at St. John Fisher, the team finally got back on its feet trouncing the Fisher grapplers by a score of 41 to 0. It was no contest whatsoever as the Rivermen executed an astounding record of 7 pins and 2 regular wins.

Coach Clarence Aikey and Assistant Coach Bill Yust believe that the team gained a great deal of valuable experience this year and feel that it has a great future potential. Even during the string of losses there were some fine individual efforts.
