Leading the team is captain, Harry Lanzi, A.A.U., Y.M.C.A., 41., and Mid-western Olympic champion in the 191 lb. class. Harry also won the Mid-American heavyweight title. In the Olympic tryouts Toledo was the only team to place more than two men. Paul Boyko and Bill Miller captured championships in their weight divisions while Ed Lanzi and Don Wem were runner-ups.

Toledo tied a collegiate record this season by winning two straight shutout matches and almost broke it against Miami. The Rocket pinning percentage of 85% was once again tops in the nation.
