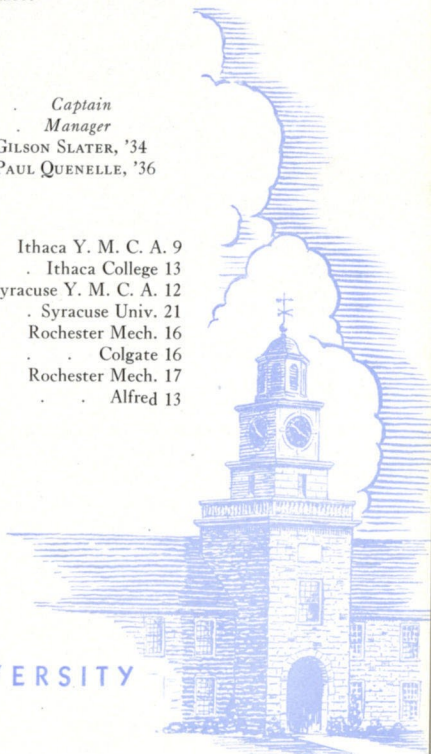

## WRESTLING

The St. Lawrence wrestling team concluded a particularly strenuous season with the fine record of six victories and two defeats. Handicapped by injuries, "Pop" Galt, stellar Larry captain, wrestling his last year for the Scarlet grapplers, was unable to duplicate his undefeated record of the two previous years. Roberge, Larry unlimited wrestler and senior, was an important unit in the team with his seven wins and one defeat. Covell, outstanding sophomore grappler, was awarded a bronze plaque donated by Director of Athletics, Clogston, and given to the wrestler who completed a perfect season of victories.

The Laurentians swept into their season with a win over the Ithaca Y. M. C. A. contingent 23-9, and continued by defeating Ithaca College and Syracuse Y. M. C. A. by scores of 15-13 and 20-12 respectively. In the Syracuse Y. M. C. A. meet handicapped by injuries, Captain Galt ended his string of victories by losing to Okum, a former intercollegiate champion. The first defeat of the season came when the Scarlet grapplers went down to defeat under the onslaught of a more experienced Syracuse University team. Baltz and Covell gained falls for the home team. In this meet, Roberge received the only defeat of the year.

Climbing back from their losing streak of the week before, the Larries showed ability in defeating Rochester Mechanics and Colgate by scores of 20-16 and 20-16. Galt was obliged to default in the Colgate meet, but the wrestling of his teammates made up for his loss.

On the down state trip, the Larries first traveled to Rochester, where the Mechanics were able to defeat them by a small margin. Wins scored by Covell, Paquette and Roberge were unable to turn the tide for St. Lawrence. In the last meet of the season the Larries rallied from their defeat of the previous night in Rochester and scored a decisive victory over their opponents. Covell won his sixth match of the season, and Roberge gained his usual fall. The final score of the meet was 21-13.

The Larries scored 145 points throughout the season to their opponents' 117 points.
