## Wrestling Tournament Tomorrow—

## Seedings Favor Mynderse in W-FL, Section 5 Test

If the wrestling coaches in the Wayne - Finger Lakes wresting conference are as shrewd as they usually are in seeding wrestlers, Mynderse Academy should win the unofficial title as conference tournament champion and send the most wrestlers on to the Section 5 semi-finals.

The tournament title would be unofficial, it was learned, because technically, this is the Section 5 quarterfinals. However, since all eight members of the W-FL are competing in the quarterfinals, it also serves as the annual conference tournament.

The event, set for Waterloo Central School tomorrow, begins at 9 a.m. with the weighins. First bouts are slated for 11 a.m. with the semi - finals due at 2 p.m. Consolation bouts will be held at 6:30 p.m. and the finals will go on at 8 p.m.

Monday, seeded the first four places in the event and if they are correct, Mynderse, the undefeated league champion, would win four titles, have four runners - up two consolation champions and one fourth place finisher.

The coaches, in a meeting

Geneva, which finished in a three way tie for second with Penn Yan and Canandaigua, is a slim choice to finish second in the tournament with Penn Yan ranked third and Canandaigua fourth.

All three schools are figured to have two champions. Geneva however, is favored to have two runners-up and three third place finishers. Penn Yan and Canandaigua are figured to have one each finishing second and third with the Mustangs having three seeded fourth to two fourth place seeds for the Braves.

Top seeded in each division daigu at 95 pounds; Dick Hadsell of Canandaigua at 103; Pete Achilles of Geneva at 112; Joe Lawrence of Newark at 120; Karl Marchenese of Geneva at 127; Paul Parkman of Penn Yan at 133; Paul Stratton of Mynderse at 138; Nick Gallina of Mynderse at 145; Steve

Ritter of Mynderse at 154; Aage Hansen of Mynderse at 165; Bill LaRock of Penn Yan at 180; Charlie Dostman of Wayne at heavyweight.

In scoring for the conference title, the champion scores 10 points, runner - up seven, third place five and fourth place two. Additional points will be awarded for pins.

The tightest battles are expected at 95 and at 138 and in several of the lighter weights.

At 138, there are two undefeated wrestlers who regularly go at that weight, plus Dick Abrams of Wayne, who is undefeated at 145 but who drops down a weight for the tournament.

Stratton is seeded first, but

this was by arbitration, mostly.

Ranked second is Carl Fredericksen of Newark, who battled

Stratton to a draw, the closest thing to a blemish on either boy's record.

At 95 pounds, Bill Frantel of Canandaigua is undefeated, but missed some action this season. Geneva's Laury Beinert has one tie on his record. The two didn't meet during the season.

The scrambles at 103 and 112 also are rated as rugged. Pete Achilles of Geneva, undefeated in all matches, had some rugged bouts during the season, though he won. He can look for more of the same in the tourney.

Winners in this meet will move on to the Section 5 semi-
