



VARSITY WRESTLING 1958-1959

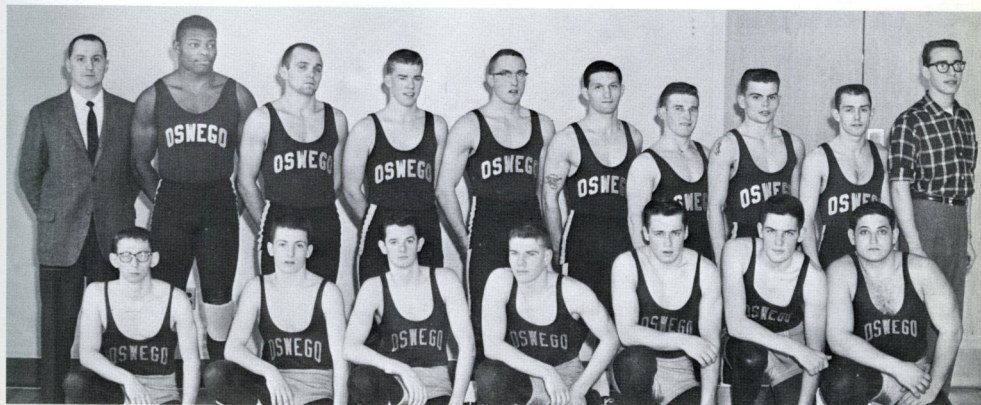
In the most ambitious schedule yet undertaken, the Oswego varsity wrestling team compiled a record of 4 wins, 4 losses and 1 tie. The Lakers scored decisive victories over U. of Buffalo, Queens University of Canada, Albany State and Hobart College. Losses were handed the Lakers by Union College, RIT, Cortland State, and Ithaca College. The season's first meet with RPI ended in a tie.

A high point of the season was Joe Farmer's heavyweight championship of the Wilkes College Tournament. Other outstanding achievements were the season records of Co-Captain Pat Augustine, 8 wins and 1 loss; Pete James, 4 wins, 2 losses and 1 tie; and Tom LaClair, who won fourth place in the post-season 4-1 tournament held at Case Tech, Cleveland, Ohio.
