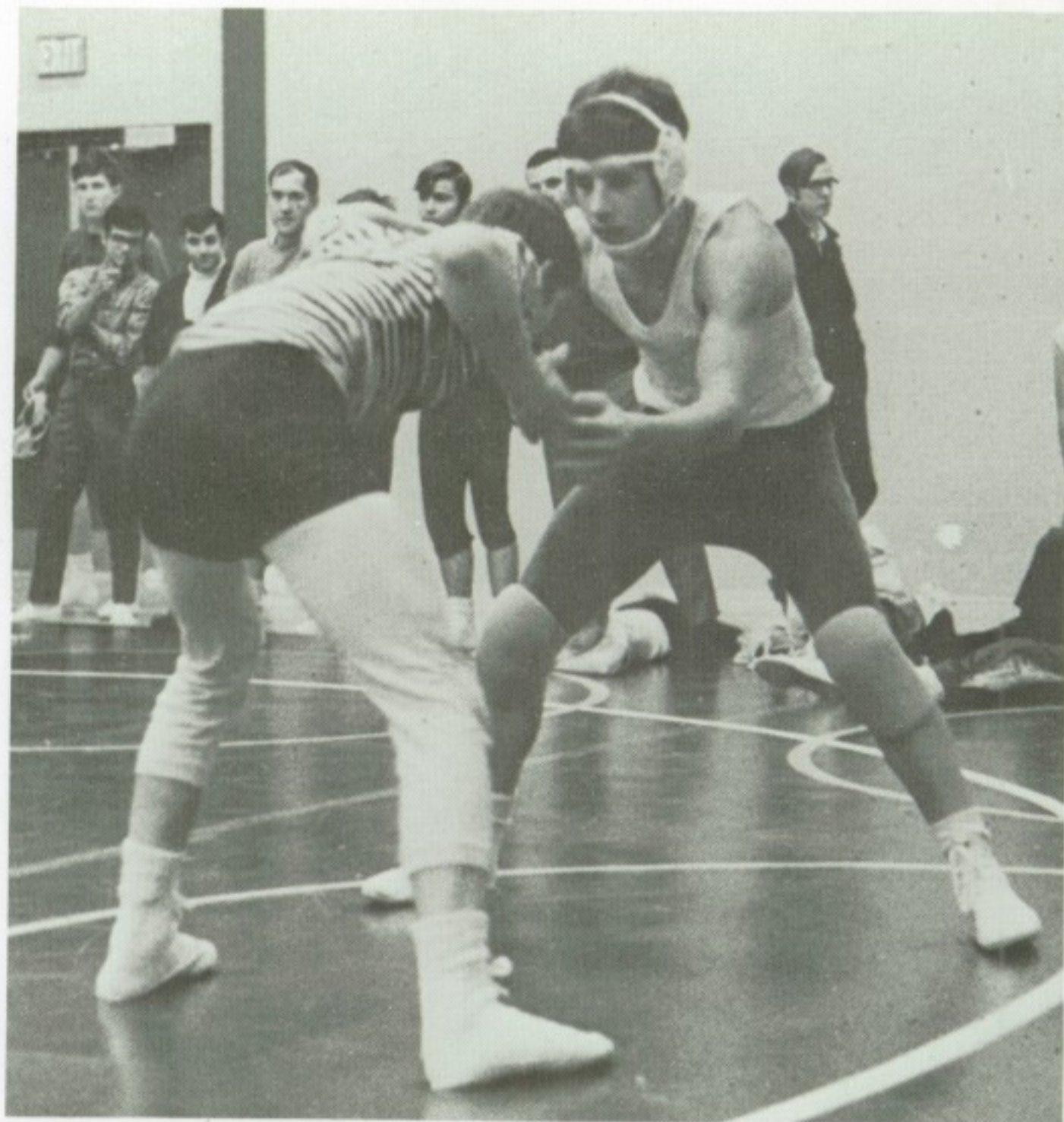


Spink First in Sectionals
