Jenks, a 12-5 winner over Wyoming's Paul Reed in an afternoon match. lost a 8-1 decision to Ron Ray of powerful Oklahoma State and was eliminated from championship competition in the 167-pound class. Jenks could qualify for the wrestlebacks and a possible third-place finish if Ray wins his next match.

Wilson and Janiak begin quarterfinal action Friday afternoon. The semifinals are Friday evening and the finals are scheduled for Saturday evening.
