Lehigh Wins Eastern Mat

Navy Finishes In Second Place

The best match of the evening was a natural - Bill Stuart of Lehigh, the top 137pound college wrestler in the country against Wayne Hicks of Navy, the second best 137pound college wrestler in the country.

The Engineers had already won the team title at the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Championships, so all the partisan Lehigh crowd of 3479 had to shout about last night at the Pitt Field House was the individual battles.

Stuart beat Hicks for the Eastern and national 137pound crowns last season and both matches were decided in overtime. They drew in a dual meet this year.

Their battle last night also went into overtime, but this time Hicks was the winner, 1-0.

"I finally got him," said Hicks, who later was awarded the Fletcher Trophy for amassing the most EIWA tournament points in a three-year career.

Hicks also was judged the tournament's outstanding wrestler by the coaches of the 16 teams.

Stuart's loss marred an otherwise all-Lehigh tournament, The Engineers amassed 85 points, 22 more than secondplace Navy, in winning their

18th Eastern crown, Army and Penn State tied for third with 60 points and Cornell finished strong with 51 points.

Pitt's Clair Riley and Jack Williams showed surprising strength in the tournament. Both were unseeded but made it all the way to the finals before losing, Riley to Dick Dewalt of Penn State at 152 pounds and Williams to Bob Buchwald of Cornell at 191.

Penn State's Joe Eremus was second at 145 pounds and the Lions also picked up three third places after losing five of seven wrestlers in the semifinals.

Leigh and Cornell each had three individual champions. Mike Caruso of Lehigh successfully defended his 123-pound title as did Jeff Stephens of Cornell at 160 pounds.

The other dethroned champion was Army's Bob Steenlage at 130 pounds. Joe Peritore of Lehigh, seeded second, scored a 3-2 decision over the Cadet.

Pete Vanderlofske of Navy was awarded the Sheridan Trophy for scoring the most number of pins (2) in the shortest time (5:58) during the tournament.

The top match of the semifinals, before a crowd of 2532, pitted Bob Robbins of Army against Elliot Tepper of Lehigh. Navy, which roots for anybody wrestling a Lehigh man, was pulling for Robbins. The Army 145-pounder, possibly spurred by the Midshipmen's cheers, pinned Tepper in 8:17.
