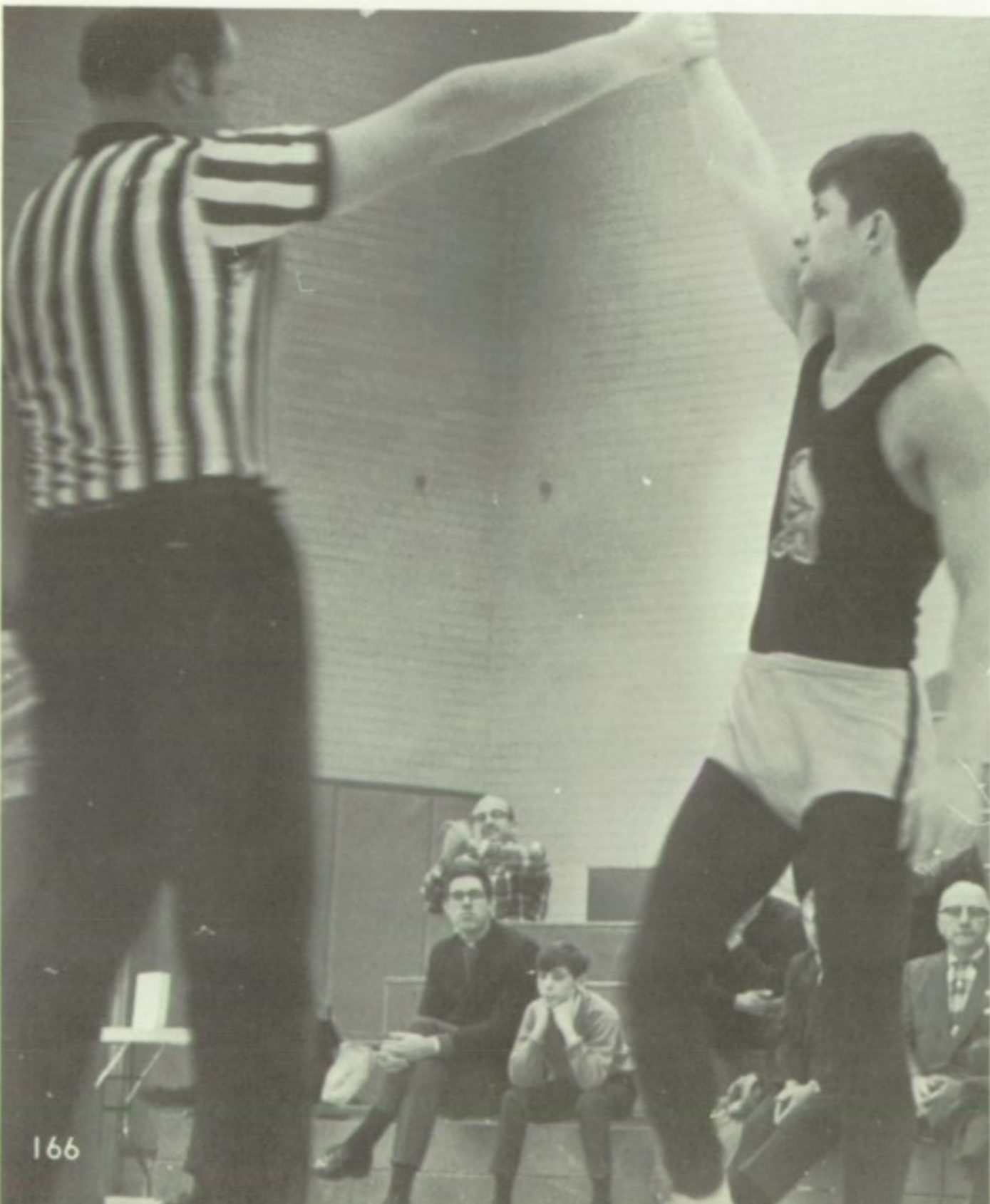

Wrestling

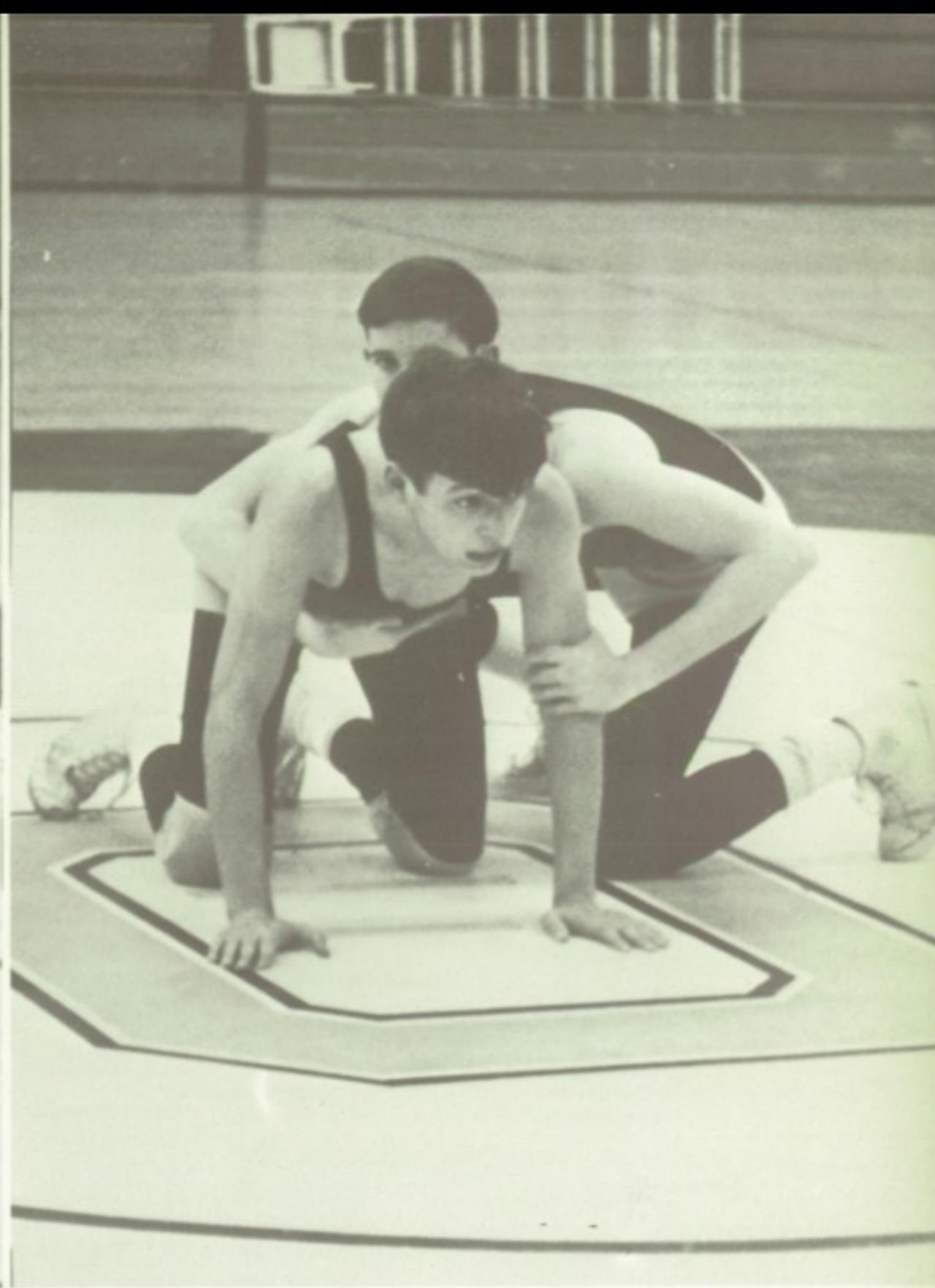
