E. Rochester 2-3-79 Ends Olean Streak at 55

OLEAN — East Rochester High School shaded Olean, 24-23, here Saturday evening to snap the state's longest scholastic wrestling winning streak at 55 matches.

John Zito's 11-4 decision over Kirk Stephen at 177 pounds clinched the verdict for Don Quinn's Bombers, impressive winners of the Town of Amherst Wrestling Tournament last month at Sweet Home.

Olean rallied to nip Canandaigua in another part of the classy quadrangular, 26-19.

Sweet Home lost twice, to East Rochester, 30-16, and to Canandaigua, 28-24.

"It was a great night for high school wrestling," said Olean Coach Mike Foster of the action before a packed gym. "Most of the matches were out of this world. All streaks have to end sometime. And this East Rochester team right now is just great."

East Rochester, coached by Hamburg native Quinn, raised its record to 11-2. They lost earlier to Canandaigua and Brighton in duals with less-than-100 percent lineups.

Canandaigua is 12-1, Olean 9-1 and Sweet Home 7-3.
