

# Bulldogs win 81-63

MANHATTAN, Kan. (UPI)—Drake and surprising Colorado State move into the finals of the NCAA Midwest Basketball Regional Saturday on the premise that opposites attract.

At stake is a trip to the NCAA semifinals next weekend in Louisville.

Drake, a team which likes to run, did, and Colorado State, a team which doesn't, didn't, and both won in Thursday night's twinbill at Kansas State University's Ahearn Fieldhouse.

Colorado State slowed down to upset cross-state rival Colorado of the Big Eight 64-56 in the nightcap after Drake, with guards Willie McCarter and Don Draper providing the spark, bolted past Texas A&M 81-63 in the opener for its 11th straight.

"We're not a running team at all and we didn't want Colorado running on us," said Ram coach Jim Williams. "We're

not going to run with Drake either... if we can help it.

"We try to stay out of foul trouble and slow them (any team) down," he said.

Colorado State never trailed Colorado's Big Eight champion after forward Cliff Shegogg's jumper gave the Rams a 35-33 edge with 16:23 remaining.

It was then the Rams did what they do best—delay, with twin 6-3 guards Lloyd and Floyd Kerr slowing it down.

Shegogg paced the Rams with 20 points and the Kerr brothers combined for 26 with Floyd getting 14.

Drake overcame a sluggish start to race past the Southwest Conference champion Aggies in the first game after leading only 32-26 at the half, the Bulldogs from the Missouri Valley opened a 43-32 bulge at the outset of the final 20 minutes and then poured it on—reeling off 19 points while Texas A&M managed only eight free throws.

"We got to the boards in the second half," Drake coach Maurice John said. "We couldn't get the fast break going until we got the rebounds."

"I thought Texas A&M handled us pretty well for a while... but we finally got them to run with us."

"Our team has been able to play any way it wants to, but we like to run," John said. "Our club was a little tight at the first... but the kids are only human."

McCarter led the assault, hitting 24 points with 16 coming in the final half. Draper added 13.

"I don't even know who this guy McCarter is," gasped the Rams' Williams. "But I guess I darn well better find out."

## NCAA college finals tonight

EVANSVILLE, Ind. (UPI)—Southwest Missouri and Kentucky Wesleyan clash tonight in the championship game of the NCAA college division basketball tournament here as the two clubs captured semifinal contests Thursday night.

Kentucky Wesleyan squeezed past American International in overtime 83-82 while surprising Southwest Missouri upset the nation's top-ranked small college quint Ashland of Ohio 58-48.

Southwest Missouri led throughout the game against Ashland, grabbing 44 rebounds to Ashland's 30. Ashland's Wayne Sokolowski, with 22 points, was high scorer in the game.

Kentucky Wesleyan and American International battled into overtime in an even game in which the lead changed hands 10 times and the score was tied five times.

Kentucky Wesleyan held a 37-36 halftime advantage, and the score was knotted at 76-76 at the end of regulation play.

As the overtime session ended, American International missed a chance for victory when Bob Rutherford missed at the free throw line on a one-and-one foul situation and the Panthers claimed the one-point decision.

The Panthers were led by George Kinsley with 22 points and John Duncan with 21. Greg Hill and Rutherford each tallied 21 for American International, located at Springfield, Mass.

the Big Eight mat meet. The only way this year could produce a tighter meet would be for the Cyclones to move into the tie situation, too.

"This should bring out the usual great competition that has characterized recent Big Eight meets," said Harold Nichols, who must add meet manager duties to his work as coach of the Cyclones. "There is much to be said for the chances of any of the first three teams. Lack of injuries, luck of the draw, and second-place points will make a big difference in settling the title."

There will be six 1968 champions available for the meet Friday and Saturday. This group includes Mike Schmauss, Iowa State, 115; Dan Gable, Iowa State, 137; Mike Grant, Oklahoma, 145; Cleo McGlory, Oklahoma, 160; Jim Duschon, Iowa State, 191; and John Ward, Oklahoma State, heavyweight.

There is at least a 50-50 chance that Schmauss will not be in the meet. He cannot make 115 this year, having missed all but the final two meets because of an injury. He will have to whip teammate Gary Wallman at 123 in trials for the right to go after another weight title.

Gable is Ready

The biggest drawing card in the meet—partly because it is held in Ames and partly because he is one of the truly great ones—will be Dan Gable, Big Eight and NCAA titleholder. Gable brings a string of 137 high school and collegiate meet victories into the meet Friday. He has whipped 17 foes this year, 15 by pins. Only Marty Willigan of Hofstra and Gary Kratzer of Indiana State have been able to avoid a Gable pin. He has a total of 73 pins in his 137 matches.
