

For the second straight year, Amherst won the ECIC Division I championship in wrestling. It was not until the last match against Frontier, however, that the grapplers clinched the title and avenged their only loss of the season. Consistent scorers were co-captains John Gullia and Jerry Murray, along with Henry Gullia, Nick Kish, and Bill Simon. At the ECIC Invitational Meet held here, three Amherst wrestlers were victorious: Henry Gullia in the 123 pound class, John Gullia in the 130 pound class and Nick Kish at 168 pounds. In Section VI competition Amherst finished sixth in a field of 10 teams. Kish retained his AAA title in the 168 pound class while Simon took second at 157 pounds.
