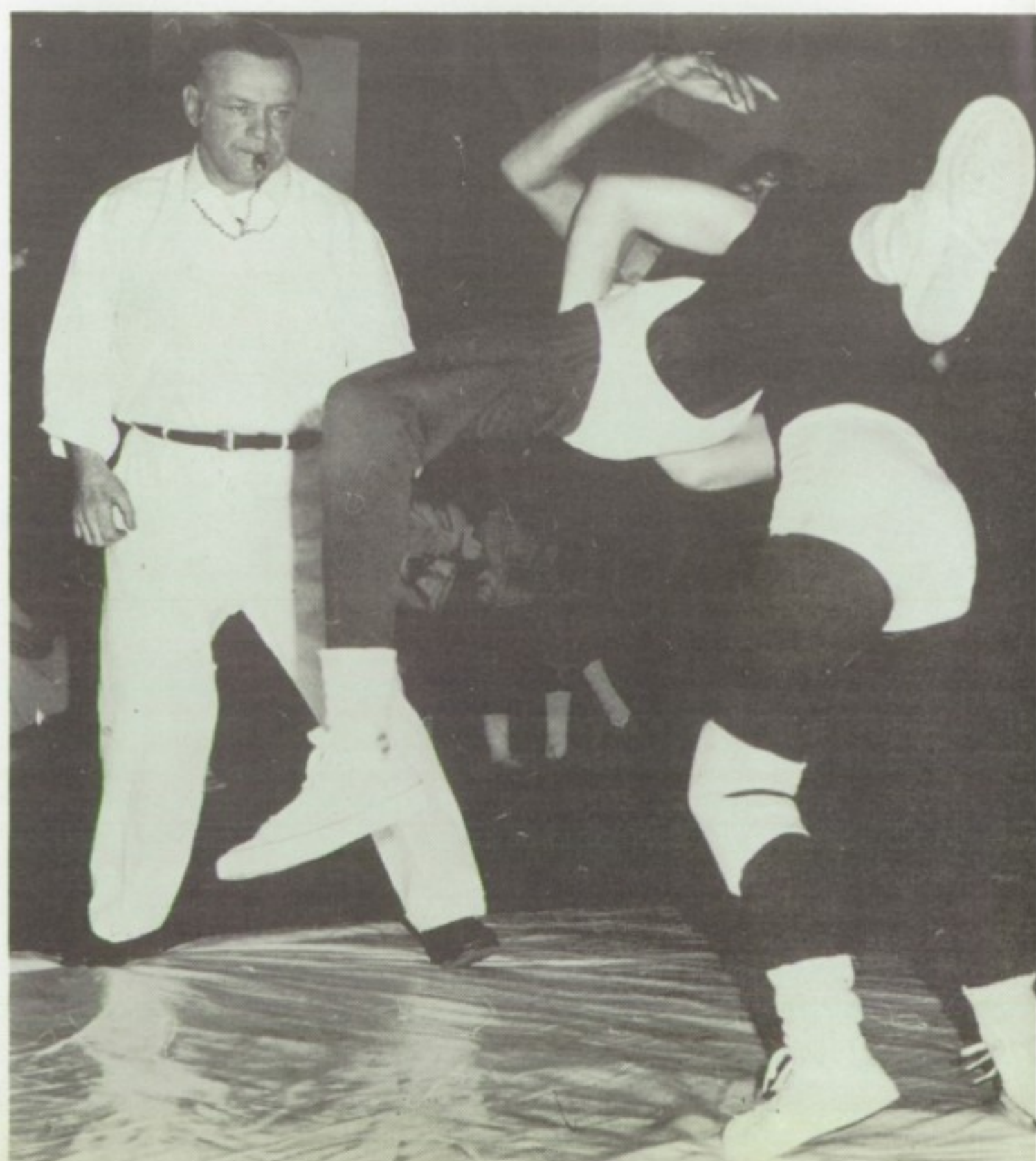
Painted Post Indians
