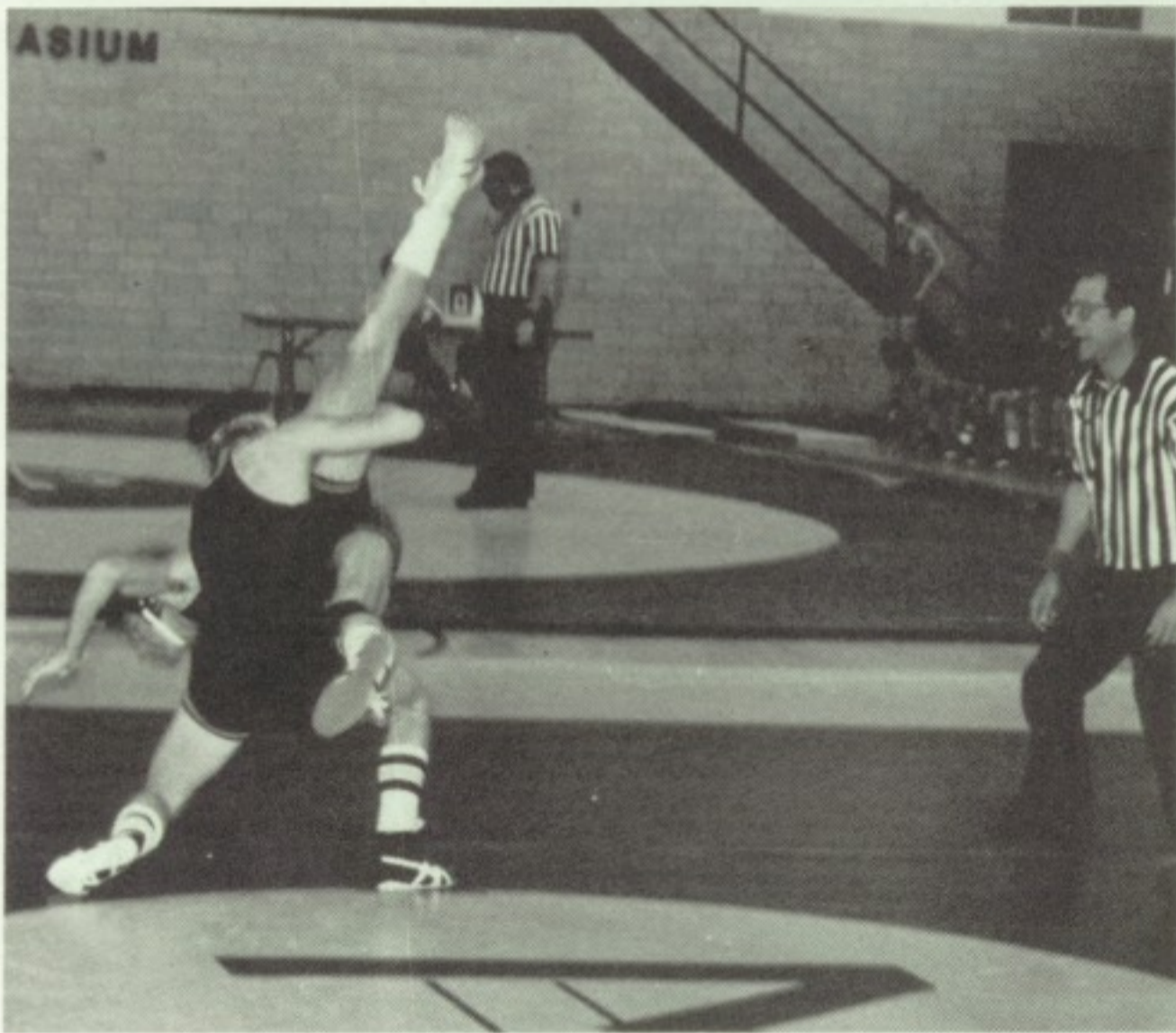
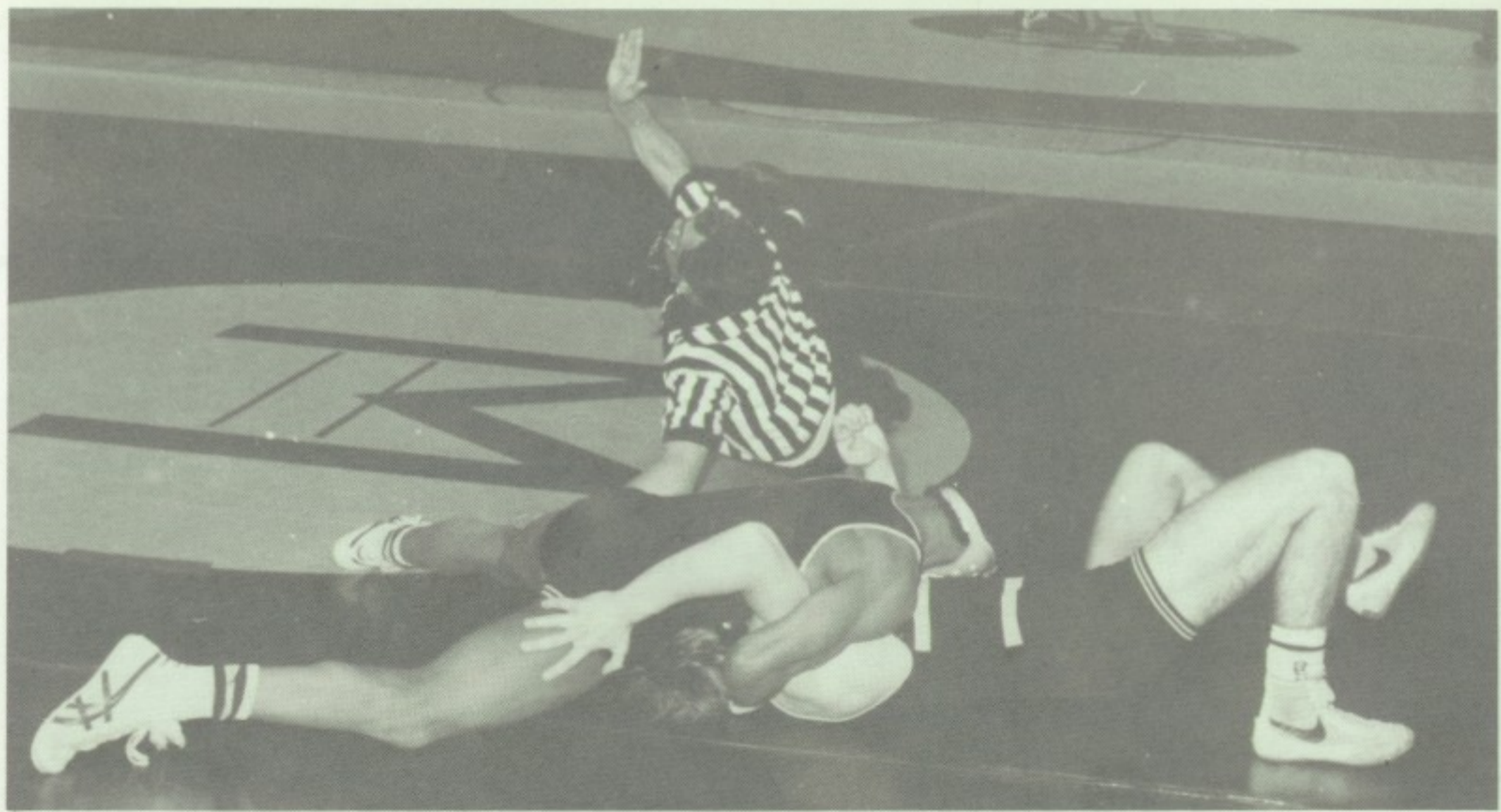




INTENSITY AND SPIRIT WERE THE KEYS TO SUCCESS FOR THIS YEAR'S MCQUAID WRESTLERS. ONCE AGAIN, MR. ROSELLI WAS ABLE TO COACH THE KNIGHTS TO A WINNING SEASON (11-3-0). THIS ACCOMPLISHMENT IS ESPECIALLY IMPRESSIVE CONSIDERING THE QUALITY OF COMPETITION SCHEDULED. SEEING THE OPPORTUNITY TO GIVE VALUABLE EXPERIENCE TO HIS TALENTED WRESTLERS, MR. ROSELLI AGREED TO BE HOSTED BY FULTON (RANKED FIRST IN THE STATE) IN A DOUBLE-DUAL ALSO INCLUDING NEW HARTFORD (ANOTHER SECTION III POWER). LOSSES TO THESE TWO TEAMS EARLY IN THE SEASON WASN'T ENOUGH TO STOP MCQUAID'S RELENTLESS TEAM FROM GETTING "BACK ON THE ROAD" TO SUCCESS. MCQUAID PLACED 6TH IN A CAST OF 32 TEAMS AT THE OLEAN TOURNAMENT (THE MOST COMPETITIVE IN THE STATE). INDIVIDUAL PLACERS INCLUDED DAVE LANZATELLA (1ST) AND BOB ZOEKE (3RD). A SOUND VICTORY OVER ARCH RIVAL BISHOP KEARNEY CAPPED THE CITY-CATHOLIC CHAMPIONSHIP FOR MCQUAID AND BROUGHT THE TROPHY BACK HOME. INTENSE WRESTLING PAID OFF IN THE FORM OF A 2ND PLACE FINISH AT THE CITY-CATHOLIC INVITATIONAL AND A 5TH PLACE FINISH AT THE SECTION V TOURNAMENT. SPECIAL CONGRATULATIONS GO TO DAVE LANZATELLA, BOB ZOEKE, MARK CALLARI, AND MIKE SCOTT WHO EARNED THE RIGHT TO COMPETE IN THE SUPER SECTIONALS.
