Dear Parents, Wrestlers, and Friends,

My first year as the Varsity Wrestling Coach at Fairport has been an exciting one. I have enjoyed working with the young men who chose to participate in the sport. The season was highlighted by several accomplishments.

In the season opener we had a nail biter against Irondequoit. By midway through the match I was no longer able to wear my tie. I also knew then that my tie would be coming off in matches to come. We were able to come out on top thanks to our heavyweight connection. The final three weights occupied by Dave Fingler, Jake Boerman, and Neil Ramage would become the backbone of our team.

From there we traveled to the Penfield Tournament and showed several schools our team's strength. By tournament end we crowned four champions and brought home a team trophy.

Throughout the rest of the season we experienced our ups and downs, as any team does. However by season's end all of our wrestlers were ready to wrestle, having their best showing from top to bottom in the Class A Sectional Tournament. As a team we took sixth place, finishing ahead of league champions Webster, advancing five wrestlers to the Super Sectional Tournament. Among the five qualifiers were our triple threat connection along with Kyle Tellex and a watered down Chad Cullen. Every one of our wrestlers at the Class A's demonstrated hard nosed wrestling. This is the type of wrestling that it takes to be a champion. After witnessing this I knew we would have another tough team next year and for years to come.

Our team is graduating six seniors and their absence will be felt. However, we have lots of depth as well as talent coming back. Next year's team will be led by Neil Ramage, Jake Boerman, Chad Cullen and Kyle Tellex, all return as Super Sectional qualifiers. Boerman returns as a two-time Class A Champion. Also returning from this year's varsity squad are Matt Cunningham, Joe Hladis, Joe Fingler, Josh Salzman, and our injured 103 pounder Aaron Rowe.

Also making some noise next year will be JV All-County wrestlers Albert Van Laeken and Joe Hanna. Other returning wrestlers with varsity experience include Steve McElvain, Shawn Reiss, Jim "cross-wrist" Kenny, and Dan Szweda.

Our future looks bright as long as our wrestlers continue to work hard on and off the mat (which means in the classroom!!). I look forward to seeing the wrestlers this spring, at summer camp, and next season.




Jamie Freyn 119, Senior Varsity Record: 8–8



Varsity Record: 2-13



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Tom Pearsall 171, Senior


Varsity Record: 2-7


Sacha Vafaesefat 189, Senior

Joe Hladis 135, Junior


Varsity Record: 14-13

Varsity Record: 26-7





Varsity Record: 29-9



Kyle Tellex 112, Sophomore


Varsity Record: 19–12 JV Record: 3–0


Steve McElvain 160, Sophomore Varsity Record: 0–3


Joe Hanna 96, Freshman Varsity Record: 1–0


JV Record: 8-7






Brian Baniewicz 119, Freshman




Varsity Record: 8–14 JV Record: 10–2

Jim Kenney 130, Freshman


Varsity Record: 1–0 JV Record: 11–12

Albert Van Laeken 140, Freshman


JV Record: 8-17


Steve Hassett 145, Freshman

Mike Germano 145, Freshman





Pete Reynolds 152, Freshman




Dan Szweda 160, Freshman

Joe Briggs 189, Freshman




Matt Winkler 189, Freshman
